1. BACKGROUND

PlayHQ will be replacing MyCricket from Winter 2023 so this will affect all club registrations for the coming BNJCA Summer competitions.

This document is designed to provide you with details on some of the major changes you will notice. It also provides a checklist to follow when registering your child for the BNCJA Summer competitions for your club.

Changes for Players:

There will be a single PlayHQ account (based on your email) which:

- is owned by the parent/guardian who then adds children/dependants to the account for the relevant competitions and programs, e.g. Master Basters or Junior Cricket.
- is used for all PlayHQ activities, e.g. playing, registrations, administration.



Important Note: Senior players use their own PlayHQ account to register for relevant competitions. When your child is over 18, they will be able to 'claim' their account in their own name.

Online Registrations

As with MyCricket, every participant **must** register online to their club (clubs will **NOT** be able to register any players manually).



Important Note: FairPlay vouchers can now be dealt with as part of the standard junior registration in PlayHQ. Refer to [Claiming a FairPlay Voucher](#) for details.

National Registration Fee (NRF) - Players only

The National Registration Fee (paid by players only) includes the player insurance, PlayHQ fee and Community Apps fee. The insurance component is not new to junior players but it is a new insurance model for senior players.

The NRF for 2023/2024 is:

- **Juniors** (Under 18 at September 1st) = \$16.00
- **Seniors** (18 or older at September 1st) = \$22.50

The NRF is applied to both juniors and seniors at the point of their **first player registration** of the season. It is an annual fee that covers all games/competitions for the player for the current season **AND** the next consecutive season, e.g. Winter 2023 AND Summer 2023/24 or Summer 2023/24 AND Winter 2024 (**NOT** Summer 2023/24 AND Summer 2024/25). This means that those players who registered in PlayHQ for the Winter Warehouse competitions will not have to pay the NRF when they register for summer!



Important Note: This is different to the insurance model for juniors in MyCricket, where the insurance was applied to junior registrations for both Summer and Winter.

MyCricket App & Stats

A lot of you will be wondering what's going to happen with your MyCricket historical stats. The section is designed to allay your concerns about anything being lost.

MyCricket App

- The MyCricket App remains the home of all fixtures – all information will be transferred gradually to live through the MyCricket App. Historical data will not be transferred immediately on registering in PlayHQ. Refer to [Player Stats](#) below for details.
- You will continue using the app as normal.

We will be providing more information relating to fixtures, scoring, ladders, etc a bit further on in this process. For now, we are concentrating on getting players registered so that Brisbane North can create the competitions.

Competition History

- None of the cricket history in MyCricket is being deleted.

Player Stats

- None of the player stats in MyCricket is being deleted.
- A process will be available in the future that will allow you to 'claim' MyCricket stats but for now we just need players to get registered. (Some players may choose NOT to claim their stats – it will be a personal choice.



Important Note: Players need to be registered and competitions started in PlayHQ before historical stats claiming can begin!

Your Cricket ID (Not Your MyCricket ID Number)

What is a Cricket ID?

It is important to know that a **Cricket ID** is **NOT** your MyCricket ID number(s).

A **Cricket ID** is:

- your single cricket account for all digital products and services.
- email based – not an ID number
- linked to your PlayHQ account the first time you register a player under your PlayHQ account.

Most of you may already have one and not be aware of it, e.g. it may have been created via the MyCricket App or CA Live App or by the Australian Cricket Family when enrolling for cricket courses or purchasing match tickets.

Part of the process of registering for the first time is linking your **Cricket ID** to your PlayHQ account.

Your Cricket ID will be used to unlock personalised digital experiences moving forward. It will also be used in a future process to move your stats across from MyCricket.



Important Note: Step 2 in the [Registration Checklist for Players and Parents](#) below describes how to check if you have a Cricket ID or how to set one up if you don't.

MyCricket ID Number (Player Stat Profile)

- This was the unique number housing your career stats in MyCricket. It is **NOT** the ID you will be linking to during the first player registration and is not required for the moment.



Important Note: A process will be made available in the future that will allow you to link your MyCricket ID number(s) to your Cricket ID. That future process will allow you to 'claim' the historical MyCricket stats if desired.

2. REGISTRATION CHECKLIST FOR PLAYERS AND PARENTS

Set out below is the recommended order to register for Summer 2023/24:

1. Create or Login to your PlayHQ Account at <https://www.playhq.com/signup>.
 - If you have an existing PlayHQ login, say from another sport like AFL, it will be the same account used to register for cricket.
 - If you don't have an existing PlayHQ login, go to <https://www.playhq.com/signup>, enter your details including a password and click **Sign up**. Just create the account at this point – we'll be discussing registering your child shortly.



Important Note for Juniors: Please remember this account needs to be in the parent/guardian's name. You can add your child/children to your account via the registration process (step 3 and 4 below).

Note: Once the PlayHQ account exists, you can update the details, e.g. mobile phone number, email address or privacy settings, at any stage by logging into your PlayHQ account using the email address and password and selecting **My Account** from the drop-down arrow beside your name in the right-hand corner of the screen.



2. Create or Login to your Cricket ID Account at <https://id.cricket.com.au/login>. This step identifies how to check if you have a Cricket ID or to set one up if you don't.
 - If you are unsure if you have a Cricket ID (remember this is **NOT** your MyCricket ID number), click on **Forgot Password**, enter your email address and click **Send password reset email**. You will be sent an email stating that a request has been made to reset the password for your Cricket ID. Click **Reset my password** in this email. Enter and confirm your new password.
 - If you don't have a Cricket ID, click on **Don't have Cricket ID? Sign up** and enter your details and click **Create Cricket ID**.



Important Note: Once the Cricket ID exists, you can update the details at any stage by logging into your Cricket ID using the email address and password.

3. Now that you know you have both a PlayHQ Account and Cricket ID, go to <https://play.cricket.com.au/>, search for your club and select the registration you require.
4. Register to the relevant product(s):
 - (a) If you are not already logged into your PlayHQ account, enter your login details and click **Log In**.
 - (b) You will be asked who you would like to register. For juniors, you will choose the **I am registering someone else** option and then click **Continue (Seniors will choose I am registering myself)**.
 - (c) Now you need to choose the role, e.g. **Player** and click **Continue**.
 - (d) Next you need to enter the participant's details, taking care that the correct details are entered. Once you move past this page, the first name, last name and date of birth will not be editable. Once you've entered all the information, click **Save and Continue**.

- (e) Acknowledge the terms and conditions on the **Fees** page and click **Continue**.
- (f) For the first registration only, you will be asked to link your Cricket ID to your PlayHQ account. Click **Link Cricket ID** and enter your Email and Password. When you are returned to the **Link your Cricket ID** page, a green box should display identifying that the id has been linked to your account. Click **Continue**.



- (g) The final step is where you will be asked to pay the NRF (first registration only for the season) and any subsequent club fees. Enter the details and click **Confirm purchase**. Your registration has been submitted to the club. Refer to [Claiming a Fairplay Voucher](#) below if you are using a voucher to pay for part or all of the registration.



Important Note: Important Note: Club, Association and Queensland Cricket administrators have limited visibility and access to Play HQ and Cricket ID accounts. If you have issues with registration the Cricket Australia Help Desk can assist with most registration requests either over the phone or via return email.

Claiming a FairPlay Voucher

1. If you have a FairPlay Voucher, at step 4.vii above, click on **I have a government voucher**.
2. You then need to select **FairPlay Voucher (QLD)** from the drop-down list, enter the **Voucher Number** and click **Apply**.

The voucher will then be applied to the total fees.



Important Note: It is important that you scan the voucher and send it through to your club so they can redeem it from the appropriate government body!
