President's 2014-15 report



Once again Brisbane North has had a most successful season. We continue to grow and in Season 2014 / 2015 we had 17 affiliate Clubs, our competition consisted of nearly 300 teams ranging from Under 8s to our Open Divisions, thereby giving over 3200 girls and boys (last season 2900) the opportunity to participate in an organised competition playing cricket, this great game of ours.

Our Super Sixes competition - U8s and U9s, Friday nights under lights at Albany Creek, at Toombul and at Valley where we have 80 teams and 572 players – continues to be a huge success.

We are an Association that regularly conduct season reviews to determine our member's wishes in regards to the running of the Association and its competitions. I believe this to be one of the main reasons why we are successful – we give our members what they want. We care.

The Association is a service to its members, and we must act in that light. To do this, we must be professional and efficient in our approach, be available to meet and talk with our members, to listen to all ideas and encourage members to feel part of the decision making. Further, we must be forward looking in our planning and develop ideas to allow the competition to maintain playing numbers and improve our resources.

There is a lot in forming that position, however, the general comments and feedback, suggest that we are accomplishing that mission. This does not mean we can be complacent; however, it does vindicate the extraordinary hard work put in by all members of the Committee. The feedback from our Delegate meetings, along with the reviews and surveys undertaken has provided many worthwhile suggestions and these are always investigated in detail during the off season by our various sub-committees. I always invite clubs to be pro-active at our Delegate meetings.

To follow on from this statement, I wish to make something clear about our Association, the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association (BNJCA). There are some persons who think we are autocratic in the manner that the Association operates. In their minds, they think that the Management Committee makes decisions in isolation of its affiliated Clubs and Delegate body. However, this is far from the truth. We are a very democratically run organisation, run by a Management Committee along with a very strong Club Delegate representation, who vote on the various issues and any changes to the BNJCA operations and its policies and procedures. This is one of the reasons that the BNJCA is successful in its operation.

It is with sadness that I inform you of the loss of three of our Brisbane North stalwarts during the year. Our past Patron and co-founder Mr Errold La Frantz M.B.E., our Rules Committee Chairman and past Treasurer Mr Bryan Hessey and a past Committee member, Mr David Kerr. All three gentlemen contributed much to the Association.

A special announcement - we have been successful in acquiring Kalinga Park with 5 wickets on it and a building on the property that we hope to call home at some time in the future. Thanks to our Secretary Bruce Boland, he certainly has put in a huge effort with the Council to acquire the lease at the park. The grounds will be shared by Brisbane North and our affiliated clubs, Toombul and Wilston-Norths.

I would also like to personally acknowledge the outstanding contribution of Bruce Boland, our Secretary. The recognition of his work through the Draw process and all the secretarial tasks, plus the administration, does not tell the whole story of his passion and commitment to the BNJCA. But I trust he receives due satisfaction from the growth and standing of the whole competition.

Also thanks to John Powell who has put together documentation on the Management Committee structure along with the various Sub-committees and their members. John has also documented in detail, the Representative Cricket Operations Manual. The Association is most grateful.

A huge thanks to our major sponsor, Mr Keith Dudgeon of KD Sports for his cricket ball sponsorship and for sponsoring the Premiership Caps for the Under 14 Anstey La Frantz and the Under 13 Reevesie Cup competitions.

Congratulations to the Lions, the winners of the Anstey La Frantz coached by Jon Malone and the Heat, the winners of the Reevesie Cup, coached by Michael McPhee. These competitions are eagerly sought after by our young cricketers and they are a real benefit for the selection of our Representative teams for Under 13 and Under 14.

Our representative teams were most successful at the Queensland Junior Cricket State Age Championships, winning the Under 12s, the Under 13s and Under 14s. Our Under 15 and Under 16s both finished third in their competitions. Our development Under 12 Maroon team took out the Ian Healy Cup and our development Under 14 Maroon team won the Sunshine Coast Development Carnival. Congratulations to you all.

To Keith Dudgeon, congratulations on your Life Membership of the Association and thank you for accepting the offer of Patron of the Association.

In presenting this report to our members, I am confident that the Association is operating in a position of great vibrancy and enjoyment. Our objective has always been to offer suburban level cricket to as many players as possible, irrespective of skill. We continue to benefit from having one of the best staffing committees around and it is built not only on their outstanding operational and administrative skills but also their understanding and passion for the game.

At the end of last season we reviewed the structure of the competitions and made some changes for this season. These initiatives were well received and the feedback from the clubs at the end of this season was positive. Club cricket remains at the heart of what we do and we will continually review the competition makeup to try to reflect the needs of our players.

In conclusion, I extend my thanks to everyone who contributed to another successful year for the BNJCA. The Management Committee has again been an active and effective catalyst but the efforts of all Club Delegates, clubs and other volunteers are greatly appreciated.

Draw Committee 2014-15 report



We again had a big increase in cricket player numbers this year. In the 10 years since 2005 we have gone from approx. 2400 players to a record 3200 players. There was an extra 35 teams this year. Some of this increase, 12 teams, is attributable to the affiliation of a new Club, Ambrose Treacy College, formerly Nudgee Junior, from Indooroopilly. We now have 17 affiliated clubs being part of the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association.

With great support and cooperation from all our clubs, the draw process worked smoothly. Thanks to everyone who contributed. The 2 separate competitions, Pre and Post Xmas, were run again this year and will continue into the future as it has proven to enable an efficient progression from high participation numbers before Xmas to much lower numbers after Xmas. The U14 age group was played in the afternoons again this year due to oval availability.

We held a review of the previous season competitions and as a result of listening to our clubs, we changed the competition in the U15 to U17 age groups from 3 Divisions (Div 1, Div 2 & Div 3) back to just 2 this year, U15 and Open, with no grading of players or teams. The competition for the Open division Post-Xmas was also changed back to a normal cricket competition with the ceasing of Super 8, and reverting to playing a mix of 1 and 2 day games each week instead of just one days.

Unfortunately we had another rain affected season, where we lost one days play on 6 December and one on 21 February. We lost some Super Six games on the G20 long weekend on 14 November due to player availability and again on 5 December due to rain. For the first time, when rain affected some turf wickets on 20 November, I was unable to send games to alternate venues as we had completely run out of suitable spare ovals. Fortunately we have been able to lease from the Brisbane City Council, 5 new grounds at Kalinga Park in Clayfield and after we have installed 5 new pitches, they will be operational for the 2015-16 season.

The Friday night Super Six competition, played under lights for U8 & U9, continues to grow. Numbers increased from 66 to 78 teams across all venues. These games are hosted by Valleys, Albany Creek and Toombul cricket clubs. A pleasing outcome has been the flow on increase in the number of U10 teams from 39 last year to 47 this year.

We increased the use of MyCricket to record the game results and player stats by adding U11 & U12 draws and eliminating the old abstracts. With the support of clubs, we also changed the rules to try and ensure the timely entry into MyCricket of the results and stats by teams. Unfortunately this didn't prove completely effective. Some team officials appeared to not care that players would miss out on stats awards or that the team would lose game points due to their apathy. Clubs have acknowledged that they need to increase pressure on their club members and officials to do the right thing by their players and enter game results and player stats in a timely manner.

After a review of the special Sunday competitions, ALF & Reevesie, the Reevesie Cup was changed from U15 to be an U13 competition and this proved extremely effective as a representative player selection tool and often being able to have the games at one venue, was greatly appreciated by the selectors.

Thank you to the many state schools who allowed us to use their grounds during the season. I would also like to express our appreciation for the continuing support from the Brisbane City Council, Moreton Bay Regional Council, the Warehouse Cricket Association, District Cricket Clubs north of the river and a number of private schools who all make ovals available for us to use. BNJCA could not operate such a large a competition without their assistance.

I wish to express my sympathies to the family of Bryan Hessey for their loss. Bryan wrote our Rule book each year and I had a lot of contact with him over the course of each year when we were writing or re-writing rules. He has left a huge hole in our processes which we needed to fill. Geoff Cowles, Bryan's competent deputy, has taken up the task and we hope that there is a smooth transition.

Finally thanks to Glyn Netto for his Draw assistance, Geoff Cowles for his input to the Rules, Ian Rushton for MyCricket support and my fellow committee members for their tolerance during the year.

Grants Committee 2014-15 report



Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in ensuring that grounds that are used by the Zone, are kept in a safe and useable condition. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website www.bnjca.org.au

The following grants were provided to affiliated clubs in 2014-15:

Valley DCC	\$722 for Hilda Road
Valley DCC	\$727 for Corramulling Park
Redcliffe City	\$916 for Scarborough State School
Grants total	\$2,365

For the first time, BNJCA also applied for grants during the year. After having signed a lease on 5 ovals at Kalinga Park, Clayfield from the Brisbane City Council (BCC) we applied for a grant to install 5 cricket pitches with synthetic covering on each. We were successful in receiving **\$39,477** in contribution towards the total cost of \$45,854. In partnership with Wilston-Norths and Toombul Cricket Clubs we have now constructed these 5 new pitches and they will be used in the 2015-16 season. We also applied for a grant from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund to purchase 6 portable shade shelters for use on these ovals and for use by travelling teams and the U16 State Championships. Again we were successful and obtained **\$9,400** towards the total cost of \$10,935.

We are in the process of acquiring a building at Kalinga Park, Bertha St, Clayfield so we will be able to have a BNJCA headquarters; a place for our meetings, somewhere to display our trophies and awards and a place to store our clothing stock and various assets. This is being facilitated by the BCC and will require some building improvements by them to make it suitable for us to use as a headquarters. Once we have the lease on the building we will do some security and internal building work to make it a suitable venue for meetings, for storage of equipment and for use as a canteen.

Clothing and Equipment Co-ordinator's report

This was the second year of use of the new clothing and equipment for representative cricket. We have had excellent feedback about the clothing so we hope this continues. The clothing incorporates the colours of the original 3 amalgamated zones from which Brisbane North was formed, in the form of 3 coloured lines, maroon, gold and blue, on the front of the shirt.



The Management Committee made the decision last year that all players must have a Brisbane North approved wheeled gear bag and only these were allowed to be taken away by players to the Championships and Development carnivals. Next year we will be including 2 pair of matching player pants as part of the rep player uniform, with maroon stripes down the leg and angled lines to match the shirts. We will also be allowing players to reuse clothing so we can assess the longevity and hard-wearing characteristics of the new clothes and it should allow a cost saving for some parents.

Affiliation fees 2014-15

After a review of our current and future funds requirements, the basis of charging fees was also changed from a team basis to an individual player basis, as this can be ascertained from MyCricket. The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 and the Super Six player fee was reduced to \$17.50 per player.

Player Numbers 2014-15

Total player numbers rose again this year from 2864 in 2013-14 to 3200 in 2014-15, an 11.7% increase. Clubs affiliated with BN rose from 16 to 17 with the addition of Ambrose Treacy College as a new affiliated club.



Passing of Brisbane North Members in 2014-15

Mr Errol La Frantz M.B.E.

Deceased 19 Feb 2015

On 30 August 1972, Errol was at the inaugural meeting which formed the Junior Cricket competition in North Brisbane. During the 1973/74 season the Brisbane Junior Cricket Association and the Queensland Junior Cricket Association were formed with Errol taking a significant role.

He was awarded an MBE in 1977 for services to cricket and he has Life membership of Queensland Cricket and Toombul District Cricket Club. He was the recipient of the Australian Sports Medal in 2000 and he received Life membership of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association in 2001. He accepted the role of Patron for the BNJCA in 2004.



Errol loved coming to Cap Presentation and Trophy Nights and always had wise words to impart to the players attending. His contribution to cricket has been immense, but his greatest legacy is the generations of young cricketers that now play the game through his efforts in the formation of junior cricket in Brisbane.



Mr. Bryan Hessey

Deceased 13 October 2014

Bryan was appointed BNJCA Chairman of the Rules Committee in 2000. He rewrote the Rules into a readable format and was responsible for Rules publication. He also oversaw the development of the BNJCA Constitution and was responsible for effecting necessary changes to both.

Bryan served as BNJCA Treasurer from 2001 - 2005. He introduced MYOB accounting for the Association and ensured the transparency of the BNJCA finances. He was also responsible for convening Disciplinary Committees during the period 2000 – 2005.

He relinquished the Treasurer's office in 2005 but continued to make himself available to deal with any Rules problem encountered or rewrites required and did this right up to the current 2014 Rule Book. In 2006 he was made a Life Member of BNJCA for his services to the Association.



Mr. David Kerr

Deceased 28 March 2015

David was a member of the BNJCA Management Committee from 2008 to 2011.

He was a lifelong Northern Suburbs District Cricket Club member and also was an Executive Committee member and Manager of Facilities & Equipment at Norths.

A quiet, intelligent and diligent worker, his contribution to BNJCA was often done in the background but was essential work. He was similarly involved at Norths, maintaining and repairing Norths machinery and constructing site screens and managing their facilities.

David's passing was a sudden and sad loss to his family and cricket friends.

An Australian Test great who nurtured a generation's love for the game with his commentary passed away during the season, aged 84. After Don Bradman, there has been no Australian player more famous than Richie Benaud. He stood at the top of the game throughout his rich life, first as a record-breaking leg-spinner and captain, and then as cricket's most famous – and most impersonated – broadcaster.

As a player he started out as an attacking batsman and accurate slow bowler, before growing into the first Test allrounder to reach 200 wickets and 2000 runs. Benaud was inducted into the Australian Cricket Hall of Fame at the Allan Border Medal ceremony in 2007, and a spot in the ICC Cricket Hall of Fame followed in 2009.

Born November 30, 1988, Macksville, New South Wales

He was a very good young player who made 26 first-class hundreds. In 2009, in only his second Test and at the tender age of 20, Phillip blasted back-to-back centuries against South Africa. He is the youngest player in history to achieve this. Hughes played 26 Test matches for his country. He was 63 not out when struck by a bouncer a week before his 26th birthday.

ELECTION OF LIFE MEMBER:

Ian Reeves nominated **Keith Dudgeon** as a Life Member. Ian read a brief history of Keith Dudgeon's contribution to BNJCA.

Keith was born in Cairns on 5th September 1946. He played 41 First Class Matches and 8 List A games between 1967-75. His statistics are there for you all to read on Cricinfo however there is much more to this man than being a top cricketer.

Keith Dudgeon was minuted as an attendee at the very first meeting run by our founders Errold La Frantz M.B.E., Cec Anstey O.A.M and Cliff Christensen which was held at Bishop Park in 1972, to discuss forming a junior cricket competition and Keith has been involved in junior cricket in some way ever since. Keith was very active in assisting the Committee in the running of the Valley Norths Zone 2 competition prior to the amalgamation of the Zones in 1998 to form the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association. During that time at Valley Norths Zone 2 he was a selector of Representative teams and an advisor to the Committee on the formulation of the Rules and the running of the Saturday morning competitions. As the numbers of players increased in Junior Cricket there was a push to introduce more player participation through a modified game of cricket and Keith was very much involved in introducing modified rules for cricket for the younger age groups.

He was also, in conjunction with Barry Richards the then CEO of Queensland Cricket, instrumental in introducing the Under 16 Lords Taverners competition in 1991-92. One of his many roles was as a Selector at the QJC Championships. They used to select a Queensland team from Under 16s and Keith was the City Selector and Ross Duncan the Country Selector. Keith coached the very first Under 16 Queensland Junior Cricket team. From that team there were two standout cricketers that were spoken about; one was Gary Hayden (Matthew's Hayden's elder brother) and the other, Alfie Langer, who both scored a prolific amount of runs.

On a personal note I first met Keith around 1984 when he approached me and asked me if he could coach my youngest son Dean. The answer was obviously yes. It was certainly worthwhile as my son progressed through to play First Grade cricket with Valley. But it also benefitted me in that while the coaching sessions were happening I was acting like a sponge and taking in everything that Keith was instructing. It was an experience that has been of great assistance to me personally and it has stayed with me and been instrumental in my own coaching efforts. Keith further enhanced his coaching abilities when he attended the very first Level 3 coaching course in Queensland and from there became a coaching director for Queensland Cricket

He has been a supporter of Junior Cricket for many years and has been a very generous sponsor to all of our Junior Clubs across the Association. He offered sponsorship of our Anstey/La Frantz and Reevesie Cup competitions by supplying the balls used and the caps for the winning teams. Whilst there is certainly much more that can be added to this summation of Keith's list of achievements and support for our Association, I put forward to you that Keith Edward Dudgeon, with his involvement in junior cricket since 1972, some 42 years, is very much deserving of Life Membership of the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association and I am personally delighted to nominate him this evening.


We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

BRISBANE NORTH JUNIOR CRICKET ASSOCIATION INC. NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2015

The financial statements cover Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as an individual entity. Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is a not-for-profit Association incorporated in Queensland under the Associations Incorporation Act (QLD) 1981 (as amended by the Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (QLD) 2007)('the Act').

- The principal activities of the Association for the year ended 30 June 2015 were the administration of junior cricket in the north Brisbane region.
- The functional and presentation currency of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is Australian dollars.
- Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

1. Basis of Preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Leases

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all of the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses on a straight-line basis over the life of the lease term.

(c) Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

Donations

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies continued.

Other Income

Other income is recognised on an accruals basis when the Association is entitled to it.

(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense.

Receivables and payables in the statement of assets and liabilities are shown inclusive of GST.

(e) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received.

(f) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for nil or nominal consideration have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.

Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land, is depreciated on a reducing balance basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

Leased assets and leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter or either the unexpired period of the lease or their estimated useful life.

(g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprises cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Bank overdrafts also form part of cash equivalents for the purpose of the statement of cash flows and are presented within current liabilities on the statement of assets and liabilities.

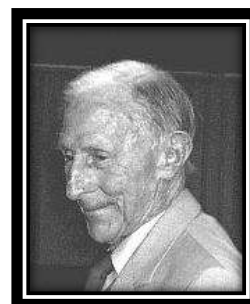

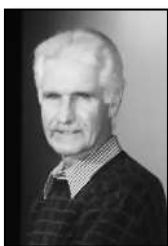

It was obviously extremely important that the player stats were entered for every game otherwise a player may miss out on the award. A new Perpetual Trophy for each age group, from 11 to Open, was initiated where the winner received a small trophy and their name was then entered on the Perpetual Trophy for that age group. Both Pre-Xmas and Post-Xmas competitions had separate awards and a separate Perpetual Trophy for each age group.

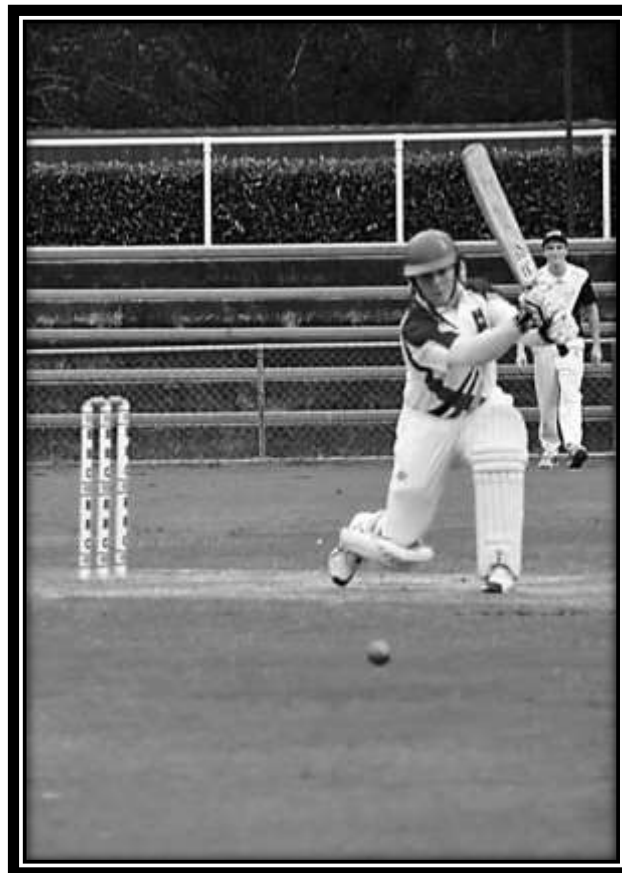
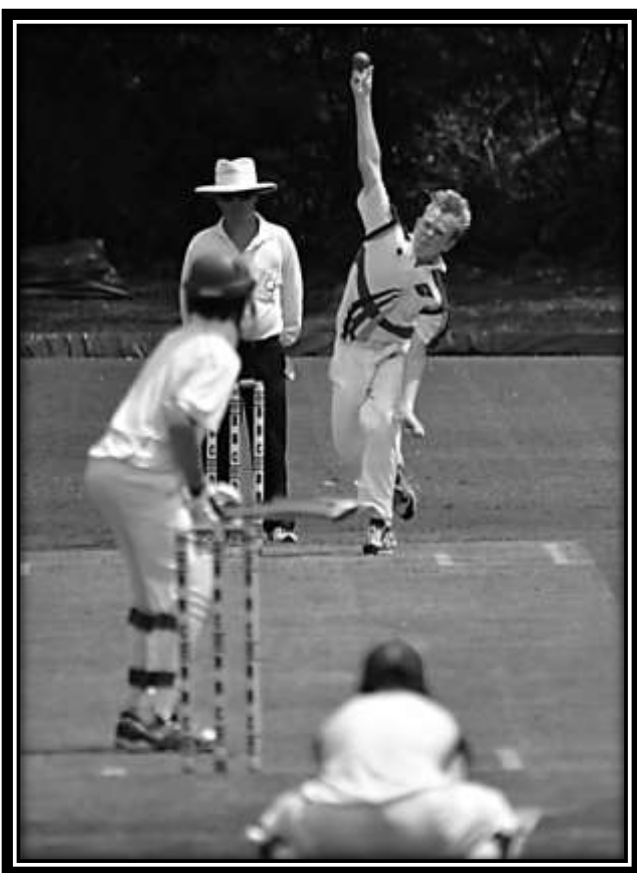

"Good, better, best – never let it rest until your good is your better and your better is your best."



Ian Reeves has been awarded an OAM for his services to junior cricket and AFL. Ask those who know Ian Reeves and they will say he has followed these words, from his father Bill, to a tee in support of junior cricket and Aussie rules.

The Warner resident was awarded a Medal (OAM) of the Order of Australia in the 2015 Australia Day Awards, after 30 years volunteering in junior cricket and Aussie rules.

"Reevesie" said it was a tip of the hat to volunteers in both sports rather than his contribution.



"It's sensational. I'm gobsmacked. It's very humbling that people nominate you for things like that," Reeves said. "I suppose it stems back to my parents (Bill and Margaret). They're the ones who brought me up to consider others and do all you can to help the community. I just remember always being interested in organised sport and helping the youth of the community."

The 72-year-old said he had loved Aussie rules and cricket while growing up in Footscray, Victoria. But after he moved to Queensland and retired from IT management, helping youngsters achieve their goals and learn life skills had been his sole focus.

Reevesie started coaching Valley District Cricket Club juniors in 1983, and is a life member of Valley District Cricket Club, Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association and Queensland Junior Cricket. He is currently the President of BNJCA and Secretary of the QJC. In 2003, he turned to Aussie rules, coaching several junior teams, and joined Aspley Hornets, where he is now junior co-ordinator.

He said none of it would have been possible without the support of his partner, Sandra Melchior, understanding his desire to help young people.

Reeves said he wanted to help young people make the most of opportunities in Australia.
