President's 2021-22 report

Sixteen years, that is quite a long time to reside in the chair. Yes, this is my sixteenth BNJCA Annual Report and my last. I am stepping down.

It has been an honour and a privilege to serve as President of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association. Must admit when I was first elected to the position of President it was not a position I really wanted.

However, when it happened, for the past sixteen seasons, I have given my heart and soul to the role and the Association. At the time I determined that there were a few things that needed to change. Also, I felt that as each new season came around, I tried to ensure that we introduced something innovative that would give our Association a forward-looking asset or improvement.

I had the desire to put our Association, the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as the Association that all the other zones in Queensland could look to, respect and possibly follow. I wanted to ensure cricket was the game that the youngsters in our community wanted to play.

Some of the changes that occurred were,

- the introduction of the Under 14 Anstey/La Frantz Shield competition,
- rules, modifications to Under 8s and U9s to open the game up by the introduction of fielding disc markers 15 metres from the bat (field 3 onside and 3 offside),
- introduction of new Representative Clothing and new design with the BNJCA Motif (named the Reevesie) on the front of the Representative playing shirt,
- computerised Draw on new Web Site,
- introduction of the Ray Wonnacott Cup (Under 13 Premiership Cup),
- introduction of Friday night cricket under lights for Under 8s and Under 9s marketed as "Super Sixes",
- introduction of the "Reevesie Cup" Under 13s competition,
- introduction of Girls cricket,
- introduction of "Casey Cup" Under 12s competition,
- acquiring Kalinga Park complex and installing five synthetic wickets,
- the introduction of the girls Under 13 Lord Mayors Cup competition and the Under 12 Diggers Cup run at Kalinga Park,
- the introduction of Frogboxes.

As the Association grew it was necessary to also put in place the policies and procedures to ensure the association was up to date with the current issues of the day such as Child Protection and everything else that is required to run a large company business to meet the demands of the day. Along with that the introduction of individual portfolios into the Management Committee. The introduction of the non-parent policy for our representative team selectors and our Representative coaches. In recent years we have had the COV-ID epidemic to cope with and overcome.

All of the above would not have been possible without the excellence of the persons that made up the Management Committees over those years. Thank you to you all. There are many that have volunteered over the years and gave an impressive contribution to the Association. There are too many to name individually however, I would like if I may to single out two people that have been a tower of strength over the years to me. Bruce Boland and John Powell, thank you.

A huge thank you to all the representatives from Queensland Cricket, the affiliated Club Presidents, and their committees, their BNJCA delegates and finally to all the volunteers from club land that go to make up the Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association. that have assisted over the years. Keith Dudgeon thank you for your sponsorship over all those years you have certainly contributed much to our ability to run our Association successfully.

The past season 2021 – 2022 has been successful in many ways even though we have had to deal with the COV-ID epidemic. The season has seen again many successes for our Association which are documented in our Annual Report, so I won't go into detail here in this report.

All I will say is that I believe that I am standing down at the right time as we BNJCA have a Management Committee with forward-looking personnel wanting to deliver to our community the best that can be offered.

So, in closing I pass the position of President and the running of the Association across to John Powell who has been the Vice President for the past ten years. I know that I am passing the baton across to a very successful motivated group.

Thank you, Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association for the journey that you have taken me on, and I must say it has been a most satisfying pleasant journey.

Many friendships have been made along the way and I am not going away completely as I have been nominated for a Vice President role. At nearly eighty years of age, I think I have had a pretty good innings.

Treasurer's 2021-22 report



The financial statements for the 2021-22 year record a net loss of \$40,376. This was a good outcome as we had extra outlays over last year for Kalinga Park, the closing of the Canteen at Kalinga Park for major renovations which reduced canteen income, an increased Administration payment, and payment for Uniforms for the 22/23 season to celebrate the 50th year of the Association.

Net assets were \$351,091 last year and they have increased to \$352,268 at 30 June 2022. We have spent money this year, which was always in our plans, but we also have physical assets as a result, so we all can see where the money has been spent. Although we have been operating the canteen for part of the season at Kalinga Park last year, the major works being undertaken have

been delayed due to the Covid-19 restrictions, necessary approvals from authorities for works to commence and engaging contractors to undertake the work.

We purchased a further 4 Frogbox camera units for televising rep games, trial games, warehouse games and targeted games during the season. The camera units can be hired out to users and clubs who want to promote their teams.

The Lord Mayors Cup for U13 Girls was again held in January 2022, with 2 other Associations attending.

In summary, despite having another very disruptive year, we ended continue to gradually construct a very good asset for the future at Kalinga Park.

Player Fees & Club Affiliation fees 2021-22

The player fee structure and affiliation fee amount for the 2021-22 season was kept the same again this year and this has not increased for the past 10 years.

The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 per player per season and the Blaster fee (formerly Super 6's) was not paid to BNJCA and was paid directly to Cricket Australia when the player signed on for Junior Blaster or Master Blaster. BNJCA does not receive any part of the Blaster sign on fee. The failure of Queensland Cricket to pay the agreed \$10,000 compensation grant has affected our registration revenue, however we continue to maintain the fees at the same level. The annual BNJCA club affiliation fee was again set at \$1 per club.

Draw Committee 2021-22 report



For the 2021/2022 season we had a total of 260 teams in the U10 – Open age groups for the Pre-Xmas draw. This was an increase from 239 teams in the Pre-Xmas draw from the previous year. Our Post Xmas draw had 146 teams which was a slight increase from last season. Unfortunately, this season we also lost some grounds from our Pre Xmas draw which made things very tight when faced with the inevitable loss of the odd oval here and then for school activities and weather interruptions.

Our Post Xmas season had many wet days, and it was a scramble to find suitable venues. I would like to thank those club officials who notified me earlier in the week that their ovals would be unavailable. There were some weekends where we had to change up to 20 venues.

When we had the major rain event in late February, BNJCA lost about 10 ovals to long term damage, and we will have enormous problems next season if these ovals cannot be brought up to playing conditions. I do urge club officials to contact schools and councils in their area to find new grounds.

In the Post Xmas draw we had to introduce One day draws for the whole season due to several odd number of teams in some competitions. Normally if we had odd numbers in U13 and U14, those Bye teams would play each other but our odd teams this season were U13 and U15. I know that coaches would prefer to play two-day games however this approach enabled games to be played as much as possible without byes.

Thank you to the many state schools who allowed us to use their grounds during the season. I would also like to express our appreciation for the continuing support from the Brisbane City Council, Moreton Bay Regional Council, the Warehouse Cricket Association, District Cricket Clubs north of the river and several private schools who all make ovals available for us to use. BNJCA could not operate such a large competition without their assistance.

I would like to acknowledge the assistance given to me by Laurie Hallam and Kathy Casey. It was a challenging season with all the weather interruptions.

Grants Committee 2021-22 report

Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in bringing new fields into use and ensuring that grounds that are used by the BNJCA, are kept in a safe and useable condition. We approve grants for repairs and new pitch installations but do not approve grants for practice nets as these are not required to play cricket on Saturday mornings. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website www.bnjca.org.au

We allocated a total of **\$8,707** on grants for pitches and with the BCC also doing ground improvements like aeration, weed control and fertilizer application, we look forward to improving the quality of facilities for all users in the future. The Management Committee is currently in negotiations with Brisbane City Council to extend these remediation works across more of the parks that we hold licences for.

We could have installed more pitches during the year and therefore made more grants, but we were limited by the Cricket Australia grant policy requiring a minimum size pitch between 25m – 28m in length and 2.4m – 2.8m in width. We have requested Queensland Cricket to consider making the pitch dimensions a more reasonable 1.8m x 23m as most pitches were in schools where the oval size meant that games were limited to a maximum U12 age group.



Ferny Fireballs pitches 3 and 4 have been upgraded with new synthetic surface. As part of the BNJCA Grants Program the BNJCA Management Committee looks forward to this new surface allowing our Juniors to better prepare them for playing on turf at older age groups, Representative Tournaments and Senior Cricket in the future.

The clothing design will remain the same as the past eight years, however in 22-23 all rep clothing will bear a commemorative logo to celebrate the Association's 50th year. In the interests of player safety, we will continue to provide players with sunscreen and long-sleeved playing shirts.

The BNJCA appreciates and acknowledges the fantastic ongoing support provided by Keith Dudgeon Sports, GFit, Emu Sportswear, Starline Promotions and Extreme Marquees.

Facilities 2021-22 report



Kalinga pitches continue to be mowed by BNJCA in addition to Brisbane City Council. The BCC has undertaken a program to aerate, weed manage and fertilize the Kalinga Park ovals again this year. With a mix of grants, club and BNJCA contributions, we have resurfaced pitches 3 & 4 at Ferny to bring them up to a high standard at a total cost of \$8,707.

Continued pitch vandalization and extreme weather conditions puts extra a burden on clubs and BNJCA. I wish to thank Valleys and Norths Seniors for the use of their two turf wickets on Saturday mornings for BNJCA's use pre-Christmas when we desperately need wickets. Also, we thank Warehouse Cricket for use of the two Seventh Brigade Parks and Marchant Oval #3 for use of these ovals each Saturday

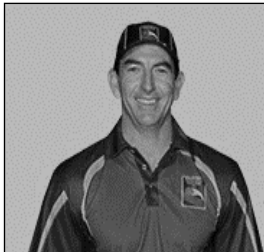
morning. The use of St Paul's, Pine Rivers CC, Norths DCC and Everton DCC grounds for Casey, Reevesie and ALF competitions is also appreciated.

We encourage clubs to actively check ovals and greenspace in their area to see if any potential new playing areas can be utilized. If some ovals are currently unable to be used because of their playing surface, please contact Nic Roberts at Qld Cricket and talk about what can be done to get them operational again, this includes any schools, parks or virgin green space.

Director of Male Coaching 2021-22 report



2021/22 was again a very different representative season for the boys.

The COVID-19 pandemic again had a dramatic effect on the representative season due to the ripple effects from funding cuts implemented by Cricket Australia. No national titles for any of the age groups were held throughout the season, resulting in no Queensland squads being selected. The funding that Queensland Cricket was providing to reduce 'State Challenge' player costs disappeared along with the hosting of State Challenges in the u13 & u15 age groups. The representative matches were limited to regional hubs only, so we only got to play against Sunshine Coast, Wide Bay & the BEARS regions. The matches were played on Sundays rather than the usual week-long tournaments.

The development carnivals were also affected. U13 development teams in this age group went out to Ipswich to contest the Les Kinnane Carnival. The u14 & u15 Development teams again visited the Sunshine Coast.

We have conducted the initial Stage 1 trials as per normal in late February & March. In fact, our nominated players for next year's rep players increased across the age groups in comparison to this season's.

There was a total of 94 nominations for the U12 boys, 88 nominations for the U13 boys and 70 nominations for the U14 boys. All four 'Casey Cup', 'Reevesie Cup' and 'Anstey La Frantz' squads have been selected, and they are scheduled to play in October 22.

A huge thank you must go to all those club volunteers who assist with the selections of these Stage 2 squads in each of the age groups.

Finally, I have decided to relinquish the position of Director of Male Coaching to pursue other interests. I wish to thank all of those who have provided support and assistance over years.

Special Awards and Recognition during the Year Qld Cricket Volunteer Monthly Awards - BNJCA recipients



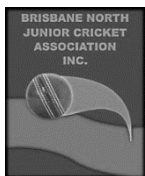
Darren Wheeler was the Queensland Cricket **Volunteer of the Year**

When you have been involved in the administration of cricket for twenty-seven years there is much that has been achieved.



NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2022

The financial statements cover Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as an individual entity. Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is a not-for-profit Association incorporated in Queensland under the Associations Incorporation Act (QLD) 1981 (as amended by the Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (QLD) 2007) ('the Act').

The principal activities of the Association for the year ended 30 June 2022 were the administration of junior cricket in the north Brisbane region.

The functional and presentation currency of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is Australian dollars. Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

1. Basis of Preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Leases

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all of the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses on a straight-line basis over the life of the lease term.

(c) Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

Donations

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received.

Other Income

Other income is recognised on an accruals basis when the Association is entitled to it.

(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the statement of assets and liabilities are shown inclusive of GST.

(e) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received.

(f) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for nil or nominal consideration have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.

Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land are depreciated on a reducing balance basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

Leased assets and leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter or either the unexpired period of the lease or their estimated useful life.

(g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Bank overdrafts also form part of cash equivalents for the purpose of the statement of cash flows and are presented within current liabilities on the statement of assets and liabilities.

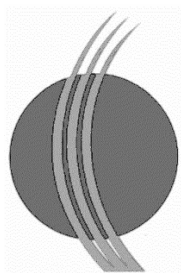

The Spirit of Cricket Award

ONE NOMINATION MET THE CRITERIA THIS YEAR

Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only within its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this spirit causes injury to the game itself. The Spirit of the Game involves respect for:

- Your opponents
- Your own captain and team
- The role of the umpires
- The game's traditional values

The BNJCA supports the Spirit of Cricket, as embodied in the preamble to the Laws of Cricket, in a tangible way, with a Spirit of Cricket Award. The Association accepts nominations from clubs for a player displaying the true spirit, traditions, and values of cricket. The player must be playing in a BNJCA competition. This award does not apply to adults.

In order for a club to nominate a player, the action must be at the player's instigation, not a result of an adult's intervention. The nomination can come from anyone involved in the game; other players, umpire, coach or spectators, but must be made through the affiliated club of the nominating person.

In January this year BNJCA hosted the Ian Healy Cup U12 Development Carnival. On the Friday night before the carnival was due to start, the carnival convenor, Steve Casey, was notified that one of the boys from the Brisbane North Maroon team was ruled out after being a close contact Covid case. After consultation with the Maroon coach, Jack O'Sullivan was called in as a replacement spinner. Jack was a very excited young man being given the opportunity to realize his representative dreams.

During the first four days of the carnival Jack played a very prominent role in his teams' success taking several wickets. On Thursday night the player ruled out was given the health clearance to play the final day's play which was a Semi Final. Jack was asked to stand aside to allow his team mate back into the squad. Jack did this gracefully and was there all day on Friday supporting his team.

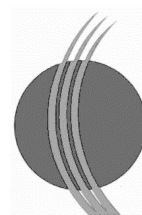
