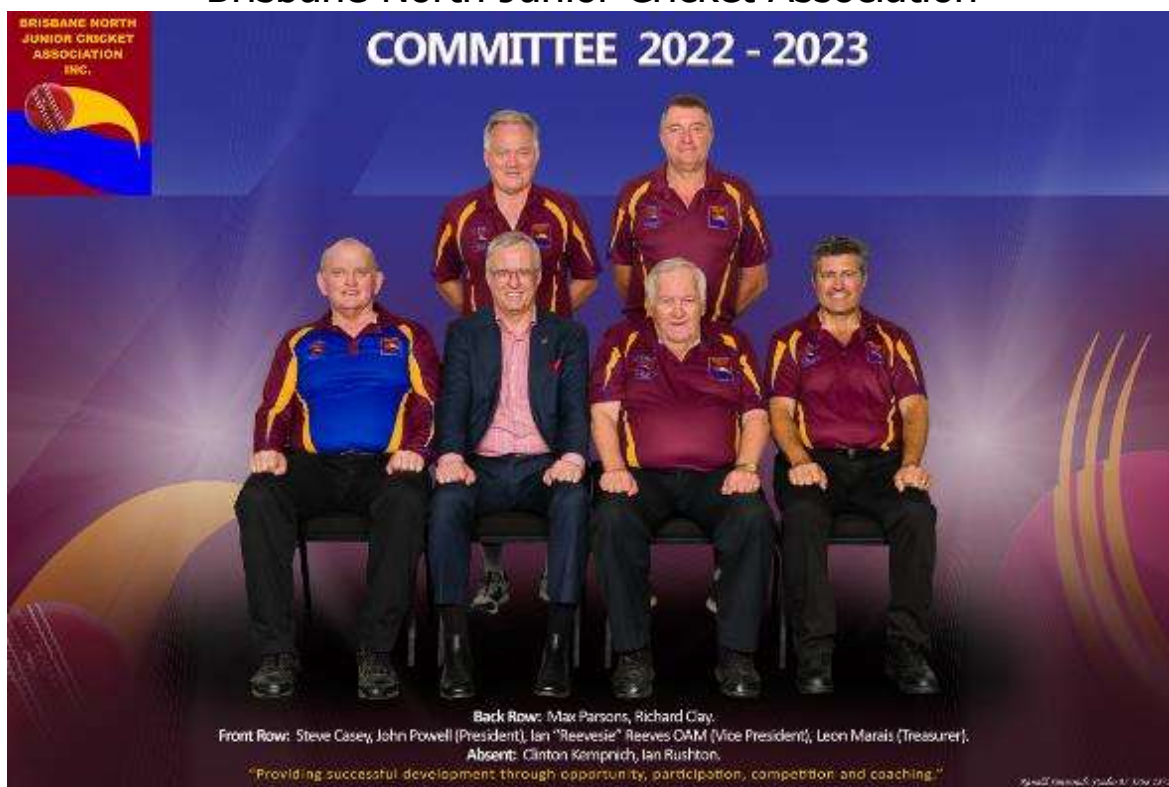

## President's 2022-23 report



We are about to embark on a new season, and for me I look back on my first year as President of this Association. The step up from Vice-President, taking over from Reevesie after his 16 years in the job did not require any change in the way the association operated, the way meetings were conducted, or the processes to get kids on the paddock each Saturday morning.

This makes me look further back to appreciate the strength and stability that has been built into this association over many years. Fifty-one to be exact.

The first twenty-six coving the establishment of junior cricket within three separate zones on the north side of Brisbane, and the last twenty-five as a single association for all of Brisbane North.

Junior cricket fixtures didn't just happen. A lot of time, thought and organising went into getting those first games underway in 1972. This history of our association is on our website where we call out Ces Anstey, Errold La Frantz and Clive Chistensen, but there have been many others who have also worked tirelessly since those early days to keep this association operating and kids playing cricket.

When I started attending Delegates meeting on behalf of Pine Rivers, there were the likes of Ray Wonnacott, Bruce Boland, Michael Skinner and Ian Reeves, all having injected many years, and some still unable to be dismissed.

It does us well, as the current management committee to follow the example of those before us as the custodians of this game, providing opportunity for lots of young players with enthusiasm and dreams.

As we look ahead to how we can build on the foundation of the past, I have set myself three goals that I would like to achieve while I'm in this role.

The first is to find ways to increase the number of players in our clubs. To do this we will look at the user experience for the kids and their parents, and try to work out what is required to develop a better user experience and one that will attract other kids by word of mouth. This may require changes to the formats of the games or even changes to playing conditions so that the kids enjoy their time playing cricket and want to keep coming back for more.

The second goal is to grow the number of juniors moving into senior cricket. We have seen significant drop off in playing numbers from Under 14s up to Opens in the boys fixtures. We need to look at why. Having observed this over several years, I think there are things that we can do to improve the user experience for these older juniors and find ways to provide a clear pathway for them to keep playing cricket with their community clubs for as long as they would like to keep playing. With all the work that has been put into the girls fixtures, we have not seen the same issues but need to make sure that whatever action we take can be provide better pathways for both boys and girls.

The third and last goal is to look for ways to engage more volunteers. There are many people that give time each week to make sure kids have been able to train during the week and, up to play on the weekend, have a field to go to, a pitch to play on, and a fixture arranged so that they have an opponent to play against. I would like to find ways that we can attract more volunteers to spread the load and reduce the potential for burnout. We need to look after our volunteers, who are the lifeblood of our game. I'm happy to hear any suggestions that may prove useful in this endeavor.

With these three goals in mind, I'm looking forward to the twelve months ahead.

## Treasurer's 2022-23 report



The financial statements for the 2022-23 year record a net loss of \$40,376. This was a good outcome as we had extra outlays over last year for Kalinga Park, the closing of the Canteen at Kalinga Park for major renovations which reduced canteen income, an increased Administration payment, and payment for Uniforms for the 22/23 season and beyond to celebrate the 50th year of the Association.

Net assets were \$351,091 last year and they have increased to \$352,268 at 30 June 2023. We have spent money this year, which was always in our plans, but we also have physical assets as a result, so we all can see where the money has been spent. Although we have not been operating the canteen for the season at Kalinga Park, the major works being undertaken have been completed and the necessary approvals from authorities for the works have been signed off.

We purchased a further 4 Frogbox camera units for televising rep games, trial games, warehouse games and targeted games during the season. The camera units can be hired out to users and clubs who want to promote their teams.

The Lord Mayors Cup for U13 Girls was not held in January 2022 due to the heavy schedule of representative and trial games. The format for the Diggers Cup was altered to games between the BNJCA and the Bears.

In summary, despite having another very disruptive year, we continue to gradually construct a very good asset for the future at Kalinga Park.

## Draw Committee 2022-23 report



For the 2022/2023 season we had a total of 254 teams in the U10 – Open age divisions in the Pre-Xmas draw. This was down about five teams on the previous year. In our Post – Xmas draw there were 136 teams. This was a slight decrease on the previous year. I feel that long range weather forecasts of severe wet weather over the summer, coupled with the number of washed-out days from the previous season may have frightened off many families.

The foreboding weather predictions did not occur however and we only had limited wet weather days where matches were abandoned.

We did lose a number of turf ovals before Xmas. This was mainly caused by clubs carrying out renovations and there was damage from the earlier flooding which wasn't completely repaired. We had also lost some school ovals and unfortunately this trend has already arisen for the upcoming summer season of 2023/2024. A number of State schools are now asking for payment.

We have lost the three synthetic ovals at Shaw Road which are going to undergo extensive renovations.

Max Parsons will be sending out Grounds surveys to all clubs in the coming weeks and I ask that clubs visually check all those grounds before replying to the Survey. Many times pitches and ovals are damaged over the winter months and this damage is not reported to BNJCA. We will include ovals from last year into our draws for next season under the impression that they are still available.

Thanks again to all those schools and Local Government Councils which have provided grounds for our competition. Thanks also to those clubs which allowed away teams access to their grounds.

Could I also thank Kathy Casey for all her assistance in compiling the draws. It is a huge task.

## Grants Committee 2022-23 report



Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in bringing new fields into use and ensuring that grounds that are used by the BNJCA, are kept in a safe and useable condition. We approve grants for repairs and new pitch installations but do not approve grants for practice nets as these are not required to play cricket on Saturday mornings. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website [www.bnjca.org.au](http://www.bnjca.org.au)

We allocated a total of **\$26,741.75** on grants for pitches and with the BCC also doing ground improvements like aeration, weed control and fertilizer application, we look forward to improving the quality of facilities for all users in the future. These grants were a combination of new pitches and upgrades to existing pitches. Some grants are also contributions as part of the Australian Cricket Infrastructure Program funding where the BNJCA was successful in a joint application along with 4 Community clubs to secure funds to upgrade existing pitches. Funds were provided to secure a new oval and pitch at Lemke Park and a replacement pitch at Mt Maria.

The Management Committee negotiates with Brisbane City Council and the Moreton Bay Regional Council to extend these remediation works across more of the parks that we hold licences for.

For the installation of pitches, we are limited by the Cricket Australia grant policy requiring a minimum size pitch between 25m – 28m in length and 2.4m – 2.8m in width. We have requested Queensland Cricket to consider making the pitch dimensions a more reasonable 1.8m x 23m as most pitches were in schools where the oval size meant that games were limited to a maximum U12 age group.

The player fee structure and affiliation fee amount for the 2022-23 season was kept the same again this year and this has not increased for the past 11 years.

The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 per player per season and the Blaster fee (formerly Super 6's) was not paid to BNJCA and was paid directly to Cricket Australia when the player signed on for Junior Blaster or Master Blaster. BNJCA does not receive any part of the Blaster sign on fee. The annual BNJCA club affiliation fee was again set at \$1 per club.

## Facilities 2022-23 report



Kalinga pitches continue to be mowed by BNJCA in addition to Brisbane City Council. The BCC has undertaken a program to aerate, weed manage and fertilize the Kalinga Park ovals again this year. This year the BNJCA coordinated a grant submission to the Australian Cricket Infrastructure Fund on behalf of Ferny, Valleys, The Lakes and Redcliffe City Juniors for the repair of pitches and we were successful in securing funding of \$13,807.

The BNJCA also provided grant funds to Albany Creek Cricket to have a pitch installed at Lemke Park. This is a new oval and thanks to the hard work of Albany Creek Cricket Club in negotiating with the Moreton Bay Regional Council to have this extra oval available for junior cricket. Also,

Valleys have negotiated to utilise the Mt Maria oval following works undertaken to upgrade the oval.

Also, we thank Warehouse Cricket for use of the two Seventh Brigade Parks and Marchant Oval #3 for use of these ovals each Saturday morning. The use of St Paul's, Pine Rivers CC, Norths DCC and Everton DCC grounds for Casey, Reevesie and ALF competitions is also appreciated.

We were hampered with not being able to use Curlew Park due to the significant repairs required as a result of the severe weather earlier in the year.

We encourage clubs to continue to actively check ovals and greenspace in their area to see if any potential new playing areas can be utilized as the number of available school ovals is decreasing due to pressures from other sporting associations to renumerate and utilize the school's space.

## Director of Coaching 2022-23 report

2022/23 was again a different representative season for both the boys and girls.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and funding cuts implemented by Cricket Australia, no national titles for any of the age groups were held throughout the season, resulting in no Queensland squads being selected. Funding from Queensland Cricket to reduce 'State Challenge' player costs was also withdrawn along with the hosting of State Challenges in the u13 & u15 age groups. This reduced the representative matches to regional hubs only, so we only got to play against Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast, Wide Bay & the BEARS regions.

The development carnivals were again held. The U13 development teams went to Ipswich to contest the Les Kinnane Carnival and Mel Bulow Cup while the U14 and U15 Development teams contested the Don Bamblin and Glynn Williams Cups on the Sunshine Coast.

During the 22-23 season the U16 boys age group contested the U16 QJC Southern Challenge and very creditable 4th.

We have conducted the initial Stage 1 trials as per normal in late February & March for both the boys' and girls' representative teams for the 23-24 season. The nominated players for next year's rep players increased across the age groups in comparison to previous seasons. There was a total of 87 nominations for the U12 boys, 83 nominations for the U13 boys and 103 nominations for the U14 boys, 79 nominations for the U15 boys, 57 nominations for the U16 boys, 27 nominations for the U13 Girls and 31 nominations for the U15 Girls.

All four 'Casey Cup', 'Reevesie Cup' and 'Anstey La Frantz' squads have been selected, and they are scheduled to play in October 23. The Girls U13 squads have been selected and they are also scheduled to play in October 23. The U15 Girls City Fever team has also been finalised and they are scheduled to have a trial game against a visiting New Zealand team in October 23.

There were 8 U15 boys selected to contest the Queensland U15 Male State Challenge selections.

A huge thank you must go to all those club volunteers who assist with the selections of these Stage 2 squads in each of the age groups.

**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**  
**FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2023**

The financial statements cover Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as an individual entity. Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is a not-for-profit Association incorporated in Queensland under the Associations Incorporation Act (QLD) 1981 (as amended by the Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (QLD) 2007) ('the Act').

The principal activities of the Association for the year ended 30 June 2023 were the administration of junior cricket in the north Brisbane region.

The functional and presentation currency of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is Australian dollars. Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

**1. Basis of Preparation**

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

**2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

**(a) Income Tax**

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

**(b) Leases**

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all of the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses on a straight-line basis over the life of the lease term.

**(c) Revenue and other income**

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

**Sale of goods**

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

**Donations**

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received.

**Other Income**

Other income is recognised on an accruals basis when the Association is entitled to it

**(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)**

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the statement of assets and liabilities are shown inclusive of GST

**(e) Inventories**

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received

**(f) Property, Plant and Equipment**

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for nil or nominal consideration have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.



**Depreciation**

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land are depreciated on a reducing balance basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

Leased assets and leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter or either the unexpired period of the lease or their estimated useful life.

**(g) Cash and cash equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Bank overdrafts also form part of cash equivalents for the purpose of the statement of cash flows and are presented within current liabilities on the statement of assets and liabilities.

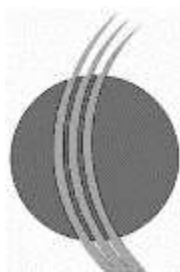

### NO NOMINATIONS MET THE CRITERIA THIS YEAR

*Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only within its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this spirit causes injury to the game itself. The Spirit of the Game involves respect for:*

- Your opponents
- Your own captain and team
- The role of the umpires
- The game's traditional values



The BNJCA supports the Spirit of Cricket, as embodied in the preamble to the Laws of Cricket, in a tangible way, with a Spirit of Cricket Award. The Association accepts nominations from clubs for a player displaying the true spirit, traditions, and values of cricket. The player must be playing in a BNJCA competition. This award does not apply to adults.

In order for a club to nominate a player, the action must be at the player's instigation, not a result of an adult's intervention. The nomination can come from anyone involved in the game; other players, umpire, coach or spectators, but must be made through the affiliated club of the nominating person.

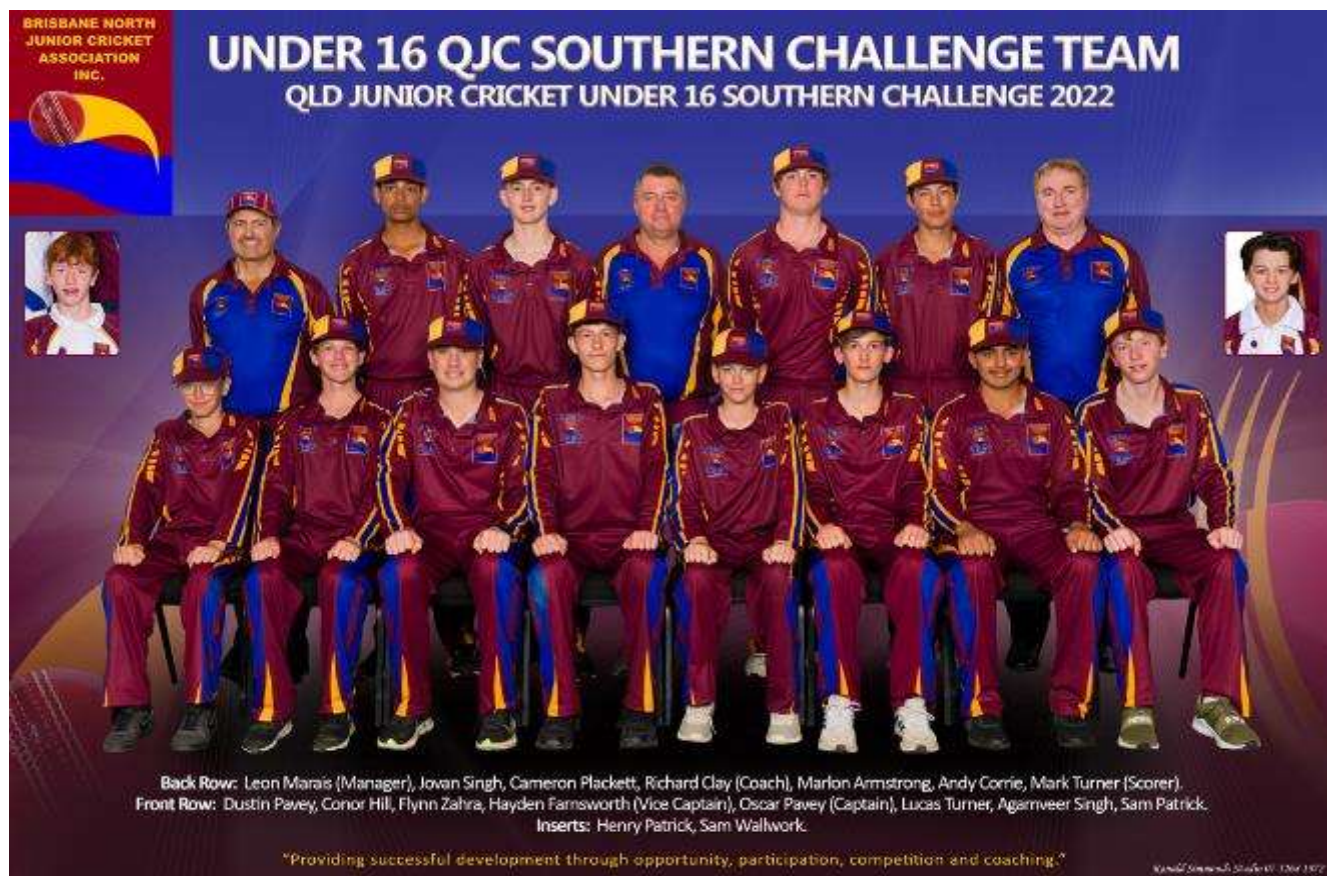

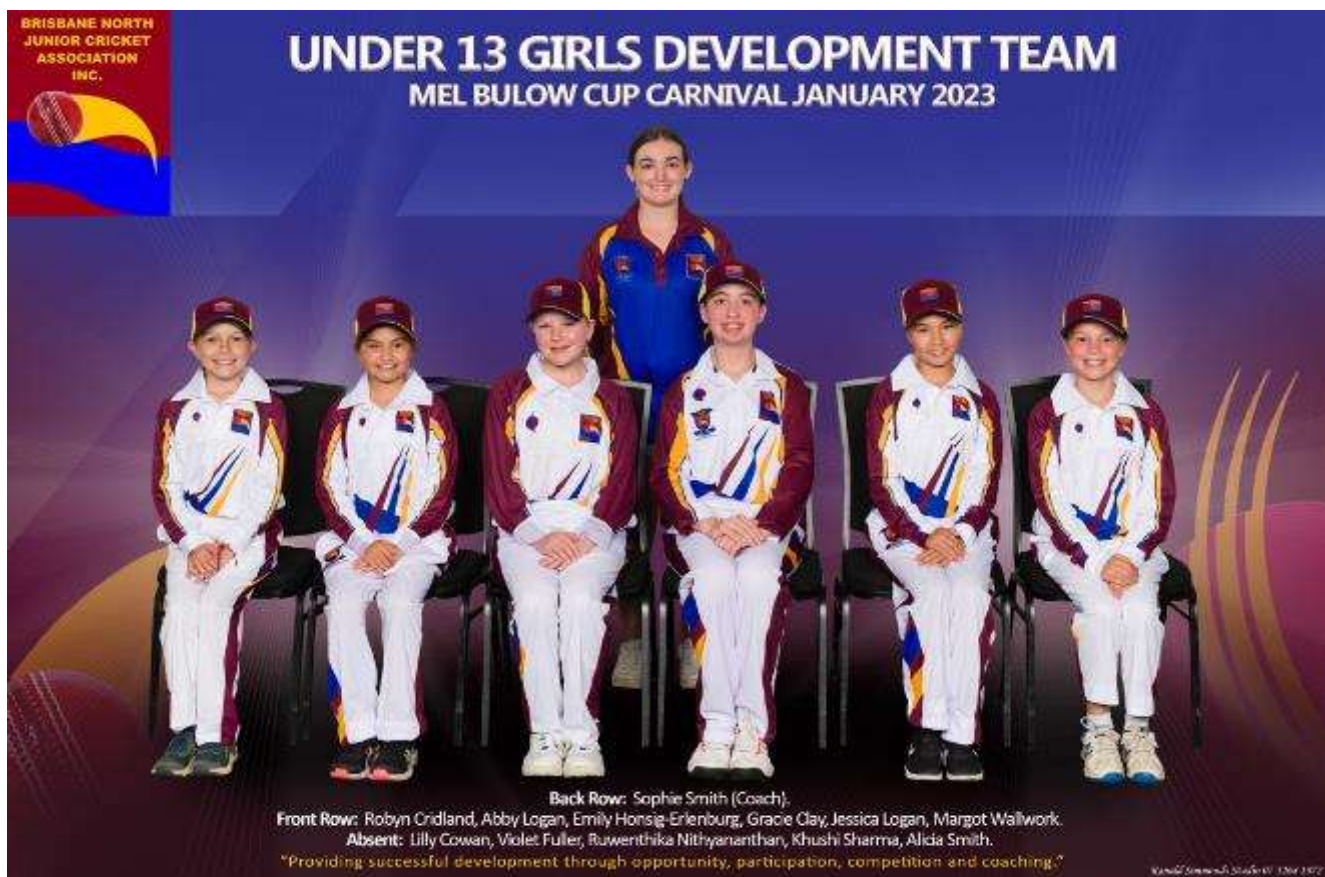
