

President's 2017-18 report



Season 2016 -2017, sensational. What a season for Brisbane North. It was a very special and innovative season with the introduction of girl's cricket along with all the other successful events that took place.

A newcomer elected to the Brisbane North Management committee for Season 2016-2017 Robert Bailey arrived with a passion to introduce Girl's Cricket as a separate

competition, a stand-alone girl's competition. He organised Girl's Cricket Camps prior to Christmas at three cricket centres and the camps were so successful that from there the participation numbers for the girls began to grow.

So much so, that two competitions were introduced post-Christmas, a Girl's 10-11 Age Group and a Girls 12-13 Age Group. These competitions turned out to be most successful and from these competitions two Brisbane North Girl's Representative Teams were selected to play at Tingalpa in the Queensland Cricket organised Heat competition.

We gained exposure for our activities in girls cricket on Channel TEN news and Cricket Australia commissioned a company named TheHUB to film a 'Case Study' on our girls competition which was broadcast worldwide. Well done Robert Bailey.

This brings me to say, nothing happens without volunteers. A huge, huge, thank you to all the people on our Management Committee who put up their hands and volunteer to do the required tasks to ensure the Brisbane North Cricket Association is operable and that all affiliated clubs participate in the competition. The Brisbane North Management Committee does probably 3/4 of its work before a single ball is bowled setting the competition up for the coming season. Likewise at Club level also budgets are set, grounds are inspected, gear is bought, coaching programs are developed, nets are renovated, players are registered, teams are formed, coaches are appointed, training times are set, balls and equipment are checked, cleaned, purchased and assembled, coaches and managers meetings are organised - and all of this is done by wonderful people who have jobs and lives and families (and their own children) to take care of. Thank you to all, you are all an inspiration.

In the lead up to the Representative part of the season the Under 14 Anstey La Frantz Shield was won by the Tigers and the Under 13 Reevesie Cup was won by the Thunder. Our young cricketers strive to be selected to play in these competitions as they are a forerunner for Representative selection for Brisbane North. Our Under 12s in Cairns and our Under 15s in Bundaberg both won the 2016 QJC State Championships. Our Under 13 Development team in Ballina were declared joint winners in most unusual circumstances as the final was abandoned.

Our long serving Committee man Glyn Netto has announced his retirement from the Brisbane North Management committee. We thank Glyn for his contribution to junior cricket over some 30 odd years. What a huge contribution Glyn.

After many years we have found new accommodation that we can call home. Commencing from this coming season we will share the new AFL building at Brendale and we look forward to a long and successful tenure at the new premises.

Draw Committee 2017-18 report

Total player numbers for the whole season dropped a little this year from 3894 in 2015-16 to **3519** in 2016-17. Clubs affiliated with BN stayed at 16. I have included a table after this report which shows our growth over the past 6 years from 2012 to 2017.

The reduction in player numbers allowed us some breathing space in the draw and with the minor increase in oval numbers this year, it meant we were able to play most games on Saturday morning and again only had to have U14 played on Saturday afternoon. Thanks to Cricket

Australia and Queensland Cricket for their financial assistance through grants of 1/3 of the cost, enabling the installation of 3 new pitches at Strathpine West State School, Mango Hill State School and Bounty Boulevarde State School. We are also hoping for success in obtaining another oval through Burpengary Cricket Club and we are investigating possible access to the old Northstar ovals at Zillmere.

I often get asked why we don't play more games on Saturday afternoon and the reason is quite simple, no ovals. District cricket, sub-district cricket, warehouse cricket and church cricket are all played on Saturday afternoon and the vast majority of ovals we use on Saturday morning are being used by these organisations in the afternoon. It is only State School ovals which are usually available and most of these are too small for older age groups. As mentioned earlier we were able to obtain some extra ovals this year. We got 3 ovals for Saturday morning use at Nudgee College, Boondall, an extra oval at Alf Shaw Park, Strathpine and two ovals at Jubilee Park, Ashgrove for girls use.

We introduced an all-girls competition this year after Xmas with 10 teams participating in an U10-11 Ferling draw and U12-U13 Perry draw. We mainly used Jubilee Park and Kalinga Park for these games. The 2 separate competitions, Pre and Post Xmas, were run again this year as it has proven to enable an efficient progression from high participation numbers before Xmas to much lower numbers after Xmas. Fortunately we did not lose any time to rain this season but there was some time lost with the excessive heat in February.

Clubs need to increase pressure on their officials to do the right thing by their players and enter game results and player stats into MyCricket in a timely manner. It has been constantly highlighted at every BNJCA meeting and is clearly stated in the rules that penalties apply for failure to comply with MyCricket statistics entry deadlines.

Thank you to the many state schools who allowed us to use their grounds during the season. I would also like to express our appreciation for the continuing support from the Brisbane City Council, Moreton Bay Regional Council, the Warehouse Cricket Association, District Cricket Clubs north of the river and a number of private schools who all make ovals available for us to use. BNJCA could not operate such a large competition without their assistance.

Finally thanks to Steve Casey and Glyn Netto for their Draw assistance, Geoff Cowles for his input to the Rules, Ian Rushton for MyCricket support and my fellow committee members for their tolerance during the year.

Treasurer's 2017-18 report



The financial statements for the 2016/17 year record a net surplus of \$31,940. This was a good outcome as we had extra outlays over last year for Girls Cricket, increased Secretary payment, extra grants and a reduced registration fee amount, with less players signing on this year, giving us a substantial reduction in surplus.

Net assets were \$211,789 last year and they have increased to \$243,857 as at 30 June 2017, providing a strong financial base for the future activities of the Association. It is unknown what the future holds regarding oval costs at schools and possible future construction of more pitches and the Association needs to be in a position in which it will be able to support these activities and the all clubs.

Player Fees & Club Affiliation fees 2017-18

The player fees structure and amount was kept the same again this year and has not increased for the past 4 years. The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 and the Super Six player fee was set at \$17.50 per season/per player. The annual BNJCA club affiliation fee was again set at \$1 per club.

The balance of talent across four teams has proved to be quite good and based on this we will run the same format next season.

A big thank you to Graham Clarke (Heat), Chris Mackie (Hurricanes), Aaron Mills (Scorchers), James Ireland (Thunder) and their respective managers for getting the boys prepared and also working with the requests of the selectors.

Grants Committee 2017-18 report

Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in bringing new fields into use and ensuring that grounds that are used by the Zone, are kept in a safe and useable condition. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website www.bnjca.org.au

Grants approved this year totalled \$2,000.00. The following grants were provided to affiliated clubs in 2017-18:

The Association successfully applied for a \$40,000 grant to implement and expand Female Cricket in our area through training camps, school visits, special coaching and coach training. We also successfully applied for 2 smaller grants of \$5,000 and \$2,000 for on-going development and support of girl's cricket.

The majority of the grant money flowed back to clubs who received \$100 per new female player. There was also a significant amount of money spent on "Come and Play" camps held at a number of locations over the Zone. Free participation shirts and caps were distributed to each player and coaching staff were all paid for their time.

The larger sized clothing is now unused and the arrangement with Qld Cricket to supply our team with some clothing for the U14 carnival is on a year to year basis.

I wish to thank Valleys and Norths Seniors for the use of their two turf wickets each on Saturday mornings for BNJCA's use pre-Christmas when we desperately need wickets.

Girl's Cricket Co-ordinator 2017-18 report

Season 2016-17 saw Brisbane North Junior Cricket to apply a new resolve and drive to the task of developing the numbers of girls participating in our Competitions. A new portfolio for Girls Cricket was added to the Management structure in order to promote the initiative. This new approach was embodied by what some may regard as the rather ambitious goal of having 1 in 3 Junior Cricketers in Brisbane North being female by the year 2023. Throughout season 2016-17 Brisbane North succeeded in rapidly increasing its female participation numbers using a multifaceted approach characterised by the following:

Girls Cricket Competition - Term 4, 2016

In October 2016 players from 24 female players aged 10 to 12 from Valleys and Wilston-Norths came together to form the first All-Girls club based Cricket Competition in the history of Brisbane North. Over 8 rounds from October until December these teams played some highly competitive games and showed significant development across this short competition.

January All-Girls Cricket Camps – 17th – 19th January 2017

In January of 2017 3 All-Girls Cricket Camps were held at Albany Creek, Sandgate and Valleys with a total of almost 90 girls attending across the 3 sites. Support was provided by Brisbane Heat Stars Jess Jonassen, Beth Mooney and Georgie Prestwidge with the Camps even attracting the attention of Channel TEN who attended and recorded a report that featured on the news that evening. A unique assessment form and 'cricket decathlon' was used to engage parents and children alike and resulted in a significant number of girls from the camps choosing to register with clubs and join the Girls Cricket Competition.

Girls Cricket Competition - Term 1, 2017

The momentum generated through Brisbane Norths efforts and the success of the January Camps allowed the Girls Cricket Competition to be expanded in the second half of the season with players from Albany Creek, Ferny Districts, Sandgate, Wilston-Norths and Valleys forming both u10/11 and u12/13 Competitions. In total 6 teams played in the u10/11 competition with 4 teams playing in the u12/13 competition for a total of 10 girls teams making it the largest All Girls club based Competition in the history of Queensland Cricket.

Heat Girls Competition – Feb & Mar 2017

In another first for Girls Cricket in Brisbane North 2 representative teams were formed to play in the Brisbane Heat Girls League at Tingalpa on Sunday mornings between February and March of 2017. Both BNJCA teams competed well throughout the League with the A side dominating the Competition after making the required adjustments to the slightly different format.

BNJCA Foundation Girls Cricket Ball – Mar 2017

On Saturday the 25th of March 2017 we saw 165 girls, siblings and their parents attend the BNJCA Foundation Girls Cricket Ball to celebrate a successful inaugural all-girls cricket season at Broncos Leagues Club. It was attended by two HEAT players and they presented awards on the night.

Girls Winter Training

With planning already underway for Season 2017-18 and numerous girls keen to continue developing their cricket over the winter, Girls Training was created on Sunday mornings using the facilities of St Joseph's Primary Bardon. These sessions were well supported with 20 - 45 very enthusiastic girls attending and enhanced with the use of bowling machines and a focus of skills evolution in a fun environment.

Girls Training Camps 2018

Organising is underway to hold training camps again next season As a part of their registration every girl who registers for the Girls 'Come & Play' programs in August and September will receive a free shirt and cap by BeastWear. We also hope to secure a grant to cover the costs of running these camps so that all girls attending will be at no cost to parents.

Coaching courses 2017

We have worked closely with Queensland Cricket to create a Girls Competition Community Coaching course, held over 2 weeks and will be based at Qld Cricket headquarters Albion with the 16th July being theory and the 23rd July forming a practical component. It is open to both males and females who wish to be part of the expansion of girls cricket in the Brisbane North region in 2017-18. Again we are working to make this course free of charge for Brisbane North participants.

We hope to continue this expansion next season with involvement of more BN affiliated clubs, possible representative carnivals, more training initiatives and developing girl's coaches within the clubs.

Ray passed away peacefully 5th of November, 2017 Aged 81 years


Ray entered cricket in 1980 with an U9 player and coached at North Star Sports Club, Zillmere for thirteen years. He was appointed Director of Junior Cricket at North Star in 1983.

He managed Brisbane North representative teams from 1984 to 1987. Brisbane North East Junior Cricket Association awarded him Life Membership in 1994, and on the restructure and amalgamation of Zone 1 & Zone 2 in 1998, life membership was recognised for the new Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association

Ray was elected Secretary of Brisbane North in 1998 and held that office until 2012. He served as Assistant Coordinator for U16 State Championships from 1998 to 2008. He was awarded the Australian Sports Medal in 2000.

BRISBANE NORTH JUNIOR CRICKET ASSOCIATION INC. NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2017

The financial statements cover Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as an individual entity. Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is a not-for-profit Association incorporated in Queensland under the Associations Incorporation Act (OLD) 1981 (as amended by the Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (OLD) 2007) ('the Act').

The principal activities of the Association for the year ended 30 June 2017 were the administration of junior cricket in the north Brisbane region.

The functional and presentation currency of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is Australian dollars. Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

1. Basis of Preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities.

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Leases

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all of the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses on a straight-line basis over the life of the lease term.

(c) Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

Donations

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received.

Other Income

Other income is recognised on an accruals basis when the Association is entitled to it

(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the statement of assets and liabilities are shown inclusive of GST

(e) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-infirst-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received

(f) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for nil or nominal consideration have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.

Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land are depreciated on a reducing balance basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

Leased assets and leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter or either the unexpired period of the lease or their estimated useful life.

(g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprises cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Bank overdrafts also form part of cash equivalents for the purpose of the statement of cash flows and are presented within current liabilities on the statement of assets and liabilities.


The Spirit of Cricket Award
