President's 2024-25 report

This has been another good year for Brisbane North Junior Cricket, organizing weekly competitions for over 2,300 juniors and sending 180 players to represent our association at Queensland Junior Cricket events and zone development carnivals. Our Executive Officer, Max Parsons, continues to do a mountain of work dealing with the many lease agreements that are necessary for using council grounds, dealing with inbound and outbound grants, managing the finances of the organization, booking all the representative accommodation and transport, searching for sponsorship, and many more tasks. The last part of the previous sentence is because I'm sure there will be items on Max's to-do list that I will forget.

We have noticed over many years that fewer people volunteer in sporting associations and there is sometimes an expectation that associations will employ people to manage their workload. However, this could only be achieved by funding such roles through player registration fees. This is a path that we would rather avoid because it could cause our sport to become unaffordable for some players.

In mentioning player registration fees, it is worth mentioning that we have raised the player registration fee for the coming season from \$25 to \$30. This has been the first increase since we moved from team registration fees to player registration fees leading into the 2015/16 season. This increase has been necessary to continue our normal operations without drawing down savings. If we were to draw down savings, we would only be delaying a fee increase and we would have no buffer to manage any un-forecast financial challenges.

Returning to the topic of volunteering, we would like to acknowledge all the people who put their hand up to help keep our affiliate clubs operating and provide great experience for all the junior cricketers in our area. We would also like to make it known that there are also volunteering opportunities with the association. As our lives are deluged with more and more technology, we are always on the lookout for people with technological skills.

At the beginning of this report, I mentioned our registrations number of over 2,300 juniors. While this number may be impressive, it is still short of the 3,400 juniors that were playing about 9 or 10 years ago. There has been a lot of discussion about players dropping out around the U14 age group and what formats the players would most enjoy. We are always keen to hear perspectives from players, parents and club officials as to how we can provide opportunities and enjoyment for more junior players.

Our drive here is to get kids active, and to provide access to a sport they can play as well as watch on television. If we can provide an enjoyable environment for kids to play cricket, it is our hope that more of them will continue to play cricket after they leave the junior ranks. This will be good for all the community clubs in our region.

As we look ahead to the 2025/26 season, we are also looking for initiatives to provide new opportunities that are connected to our game. We are still working on developing an umpiring program in partnership with the Queensland Umpires and Scorers Association, and as we make progress, we will post updates both on Facebook and on our website. Another new program we are trying to implement is a winter academy for all the players selected in our Stage 2 representative program. This will focus on aspects of the game that are not coached in cricket nets and are sometimes overlooked. We hope that this academy will help to prepare all these players for the Stage 2 and Stage 3 competitions in our representative program.

To close, I would like to thank the members of the Management Committee for their dedication to our game and to our association. I have already mentioned Max by name, but I would also like to call out Steve and Kathy Casey for the enormous amount of work that they do for the association. All the other members of the management committee appreciate their commitment and effort.

All the best to clubs for registration and in the forthcoming season.

Treasurer's 2024-25 report

The financial statements for the 2024-25 year record a net loss of \$41,964.

Net assets were \$326,143 last year and they have decreased to \$275,035 as at 30 June 2025.

We have spent funds this year, but the condition of the physical assets has improved because of this expenditure. Upgrading of the Number 4 pitch at Kalinga Park continues to be a focus of the Association and these works required considerable expenditure of funds.

In summary, despite having another very active year, we are continuing to review our operations and streamline them where possible.

The player fee structure and affiliation fee amount for the 2024-25 season was kept the same again this year and this has not increased for the past 13 years. The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 per player per season and the Blaster fee (formerly Super 6's) was not paid to BNJCA and was paid directly to Cricket Australia when the player signed on for Junior Blaster or Master Blaster. BNJCA does not receive any part of the Blaster sign on fee. The annual BNJCA club affiliation fee was again set at \$1 per club.

Draw Committee 2024-25 report

Draw Committee 2024-25 report



For the 2024/25 season we had a total of 227 teams in the U10 – Open age groups for the Pre-Xmas draw. This was a decrease from 239 teams in the Pre-Xmas draw from the previous year. Our Post Xmas draw had 125 teams which was a slight decrease from last season. These drops in team numbers were predominantly due to the change in format for our U11 draws where teams had bigger numbers in each team compared to the previous years, where teams in the U11 had only nine players per team. The U11 change of format has been a success. In previous years, players batted for a number of balls and could be dismissed several times without being out. For the first few games, teams were dismissed for relatively low scores, but this soon changed as players learnt the value of protecting their wickets and gradually scoring more runs. This will benefit them in the long run.

Unfortunately, this season we also lost some grounds from our Pre Xmas draw which made things very tight when faced with the inevitable loss of the odd oval here and then for school activities and weather interruptions. I ask that club officials be on the lookout for school ovals or council parks which could be used for our fixtures.

Our Post Xmas season had many wet days, and it was a scramble to find suitable venues. I would like to thank those club officials who notified me earlier in the week that their ovals would be unavailable.

Thank you to the many state schools who allowed us to use their grounds during the season. I would also like to express our appreciation for the continuing support from the Brisbane City Council, Moreton Bay Regional Council, the Warehouse Cricket Association, District Cricket Clubs north of the river and several private schools who all make ovals available for us to use. BNJCA could not operate such a large competition without their assistance.

I would like to acknowledge the assistance given to me by Kathy Casey. It was a challenging season with all the weather interruptions.

Grants Committee 2024-25 report

Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in bringing new fields into use and ensuring that grounds that are used by the BNJCA, are kept in a safe and useable condition. We approve grants for repairs and new pitch installations but do not approve grants for practice nets as these are not required to play cricket on Saturday mornings. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website www.bnjca.org.au

We allocated a total of **\$8,683** on grants for pitches and with the BCC also doing ground improvements like aeration, weed control and fertilizer application, we look forward to improving the quality of facilities for all users in the future. The Management Committee is currently in negotiations with Brisbane City Council to extend these remediation works across more of the parks that we hold licences for. The BNJCA contributed **\$21,575** as part of the funding required to complete the major works on Kalinga Number 4.

We continue to provide grants to clubs to upgrade the pitches that are used for the junior competitions. However, given the costs associated to have new surfaces installed on pitches we are limited to how many grants we can undertake each year. The BNJCA continues to support clubs wherever it is possible.

Representative team photos were again completed on the same evening as the Cap Presentation Night. Thanks to Randal Simmonds Photography who catered for these new arrangements and were able to deliver the photos on time.

Facilities 2024-25 report



Kalinga pitches continue to be mowed by a contractor in addition to Brisbane City Council. The Association has received complementary advice regarding the standard of the ovals at Kalinga Park, and we receive many requests to use the ovals for their community cricket games and other events. The BCC has again undertaken a program to aerate, weed manage and fertilize the Kalinga Park ovals again this year.

With a mix of grants, club and BNJCA contributions, we have resurfaced pitches the Stackpoole Oval, Martin Kent Oval, as well as contributing to the construction and resurfacing of Kalinga Number 4 at a total cost \$8683.00 These facilities increase the ovals available for the Saturday morning competitions.

Continued pitch vandalization and extreme weather conditions puts extra a burden on clubs and BNJCA.

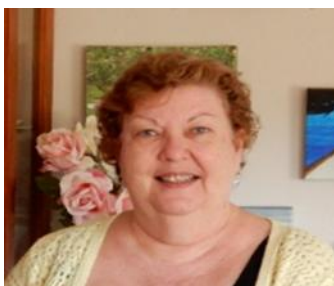

Representative Manager 2024-25 report



This year, we have added a **Rep Roundup** page to the Brisbane North web site under the **Rep Cricket** menu. The **Rep Roundup** shows all three stages of the Brisbane North Representative cycle (Stage 1, Stage 2 and Stage 3) and identifies the dates and venues for Stage 1 and 2 trials and when the outcomes are scheduled to be announced. It also provides details of where and when the Stage 3 carnivals will be held.

We added a new carnival to our Stage 2 selection process for the U15 age group. The JP Cup is played in a similar format to our other Stage 2 carnivals in that it is played over three consecutive Sundays on a round robin basis and the Stage 3 teams for the U15 age group will be selected based on performances in this carnival.

The initial Stage 1 trials were conducted as usual in February & March for both the boys' and girls' representative teams for the 25-26 season. The nominated players for next year's rep players increased across the age groups in comparison to previous seasons.

There was a total of 78 nominations for the U12 boys, 111 nominations for the U13 boys and 90 nominations for the U14 boys, 86 nominations for the U15 boys, 89 nominations for the U16 boys, 25 nominations for the U13 Girls and 27 nominations for the U15 Girls.

All four Stage 2 squads have been selected for the U12 Casey Cup, the U13 Reevesie Cup, the U14 Anstey La Frantz and the U15 JP Cup. The JP Cup will be played for July/August, and the Casey Cup, Reevesie Cup and Anstey La Frantz carnivals will be played in October. The Girls U13 and Girls U15 squads have been selected, and they are also scheduled to play their Stage 2 trial game in August.

There were seven boys selected to contest the Queensland U16 Male State Challenge and six girls selected to attend the Queensland U15 Female State Challenge.

A huge thank you must go to all those club volunteers who assist with the selections of these Stage 2 squads in each of the age groups.

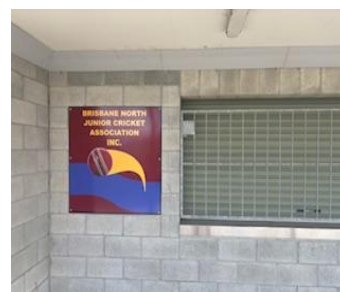

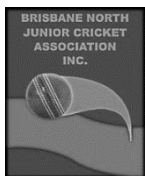

President's 2023-24 report

It's that time of year again when we take a look in the rearview mirror at what we've done and then look forward to what we plan to do for the next 12 months or more.

From an administration perspective, we've been developing a stronger structure for the association by updating policies around the service that we provide to make sure that we have accountability and good governance. Looking ahead our plan is to continue to improve our governance and to continue down the path of creating a structure for our volunteer administration that allows us to separate strategic decision making from our week-on-week tactical decision making.

In the operations space we've continued to run competitions, set up draws, and create rulebooks for new competitions. We looked at the idea of running one day games for all competitions for all rounds and we sent out a survey to try and garner the thoughts of the players but unfortunately, we only received responses from about 10% of players, so at this stage we've decided to leave things as they are and continue with mostly two day games from under 11's up with the odd one day game to fill in any gaps.

In the representative space we have continued to develop our processes to try and make sure we get the best outcomes for players and providing them the best of representative opportunities. For a few years now we've been running the Casey Cup, Reevesie Cup, and Anstey La Frantz Shield in October to facilitate the selection of our Under 12, Under 13, and Under 14 boys teams respectively. This year we've added a competition for Under 15 boys that will be run in July and August, called the JP Cup so that we can bring the same rigour to the selection process of under 15 boys as we have in those age groups below. In the girl's representative space, we will look at building a similar competition when there are enough girls in the representative process to setup a round-robin draw. Looking ahead we're working towards the development of an Academy programme that will operate between stage one and stage two of the representative selection process because we have noticed over a few years that our performances at representative level have fallen away from what they once were and a large part of this can be attributed to the standard of fielding and running between wickets and therefore, we intend to address these issues as part of our Academy programme. This Academy programme will also give young coaches an opportunity to work with larger groups and develop their coaching skills.

We mentioned in the past that we were looking to run an umpiring group. We're still looking at this initiative, however we've been waiting on responses from Queensland Cricket, and this has slowed us down somewhat.

Our aim is always to improve the opportunities for the young people in our region to be playing cricket of a Saturday morning, enjoying time with their friends, and opportunities to play cricket at a high level and developing their game further. A part of creating opportunities for young people is to help them see the opportunities that lie at the grassroot clubs that they are part of. While there were some players who will aspire to premier grade cricket as a stepping stone to higher representative honours, the reality is many players will not play cricket at representative level but can attain a lifetime of opportunities and memories by playing cricket for as long as they desire at their local club. We are committed to the growth and the longevity of all our community clubs regardless of whether they are a Premier Club, a Warehouse club or a Sub-district club. In mentioning the community clubs, I would like to thank all the club officials and the club delegates for the efforts that they have provided in the last 12 months, and we look forward to working with clubs again over the next 12 months to provide opportunities for as many people as possible to play and participate in this great game.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2024

The financial statements cover Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association as an individual entity. Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is a not-for-profit Association incorporated in Queensland under the Associations Incorporation Act (QLD) 1981 (as amended by the Associations Incorporation and Other Legislation Amendment Act (QLD) 2007) ('the Act').

The principal activities of the Association for the year ended 30 June 2023 were the administration of junior cricket in the north Brisbane region.

The functional and presentation currency of Brisbane North Junior Cricket Association is Australian dollars. Comparatives are consistent with prior years, unless otherwise stated.

1. Basis of Preparation

In the opinion of the Committee of Management, the Association is not a reporting entity since there are unlikely to exist users of the financial report who are not able to command the preparation of reports tailored so as to satisfy specifically all of their information needs. These special purpose financial statements have been prepared to meet the reporting requirements of the Act.

The financial statements have been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs modified, where applicable, by the measurement at fair value of selected non-current assets, financial assets and financial liabilities. Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these financial statements are presented below and are consistent with prior reporting periods unless otherwise stated.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Income Tax

The Association is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(b) Leases

Lease payments for operating leases, where substantially all of the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses on a straight-line basis over the life of the lease term.

(c) Revenue and other income

Revenue is recognised when the amount of the revenue can be measured reliably, it is probable that economic benefits associated with the transaction will flow to the Association and specific criteria relating to the type of revenue as noted below, has been satisfied.

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable and is presented net of returns, discounts and rebates.

All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST).

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and there is no longer any ownership or effective control over the goods.

Donations

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when received.

Other Income

Other income is recognised on an accruals basis when the Association is entitled to it

(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances, the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of the expense. Receivables and payables in the statement of assets and liabilities are shown inclusive of GST

(e) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Cost of inventory is determined using the first-in-first-out basis and is net of any rebates and discounts received

(f) Property, Plant and Equipment

Each class of property, plant and equipment is carried at cost or fair value less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation and impairment of losses.

Items of property, plant and equipment acquired for nil or nominal consideration have been recorded at the acquisition date fair value.

Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment, excluding freehold land are depreciated on a reducing balance basis over the assets useful life to the Association, commencing when the asset is ready for use.

Leased assets and leasehold improvements are amortised over the shorter or either the unexpired period of the lease or their estimated useful life.

(g) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand, demand deposits and short-term investments which are readily convertible to known amounts of cash, and which are subject to an insignificant risk of change in value.

Bank overdrafts also form part of cash equivalents for the purpose of the statement of cash flows and are presented within current liabilities on the statement of assets and liabilities.

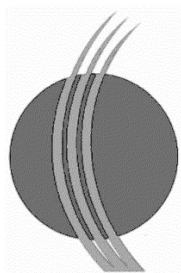

The Spirit of Cricket Award

NO NOMINATION MET THE CRITERIA THIS YEAR

Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only within its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this spirit causes injury to the game itself. The Spirit of the Game involves respect for:

- Your opponents
- Your own captain and team
- The role of the umpires
- The game's traditional values

The BNJCA supports the Spirit of Cricket, as embodied in the preamble to the Laws of Cricket, in a tangible way, with a Spirit of Cricket Award. The Association accepts nominations from clubs for a player displaying the true spirit, traditions, and values of cricket. The player must be playing in a BNJCA competition. This award does not apply to adults.

In order for a club to nominate a player, the action must be at the player's instigation, not a result of an adult's intervention. The nomination can come from anyone involved in the game; other players, umpire, coach or spectators, but must be made through the affiliated club of the nominating person.

In January this year BNJCA hosted the Ian Healy Cup U12 Development Carnival. On the Friday night before the carnival was due to start, the carnival convenor, Steve Casey, was notified that one of the boys from the Brisbane North Maroon team was ruled out after being a close contact Covid case. After consultation with the Maroon coach, Jack O'Sullivan was called in as a replacement spinner. Jack was a very excited young man being given the opportunity to realize his representative dreams.

During the first four days of the carnival Jack played a very prominent role in his teams' success taking several wickets. On Thursday night the player ruled out was given the health clearance to play the final day's play which was a Semi Final. Jack was asked to stand aside to allow his team mate back into the squad. Jack did this gracefully and was there all day on Friday supporting his team.

A very worthy recipient of this year's Spirit of Cricket Award.

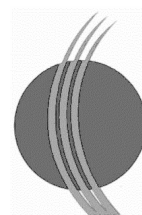

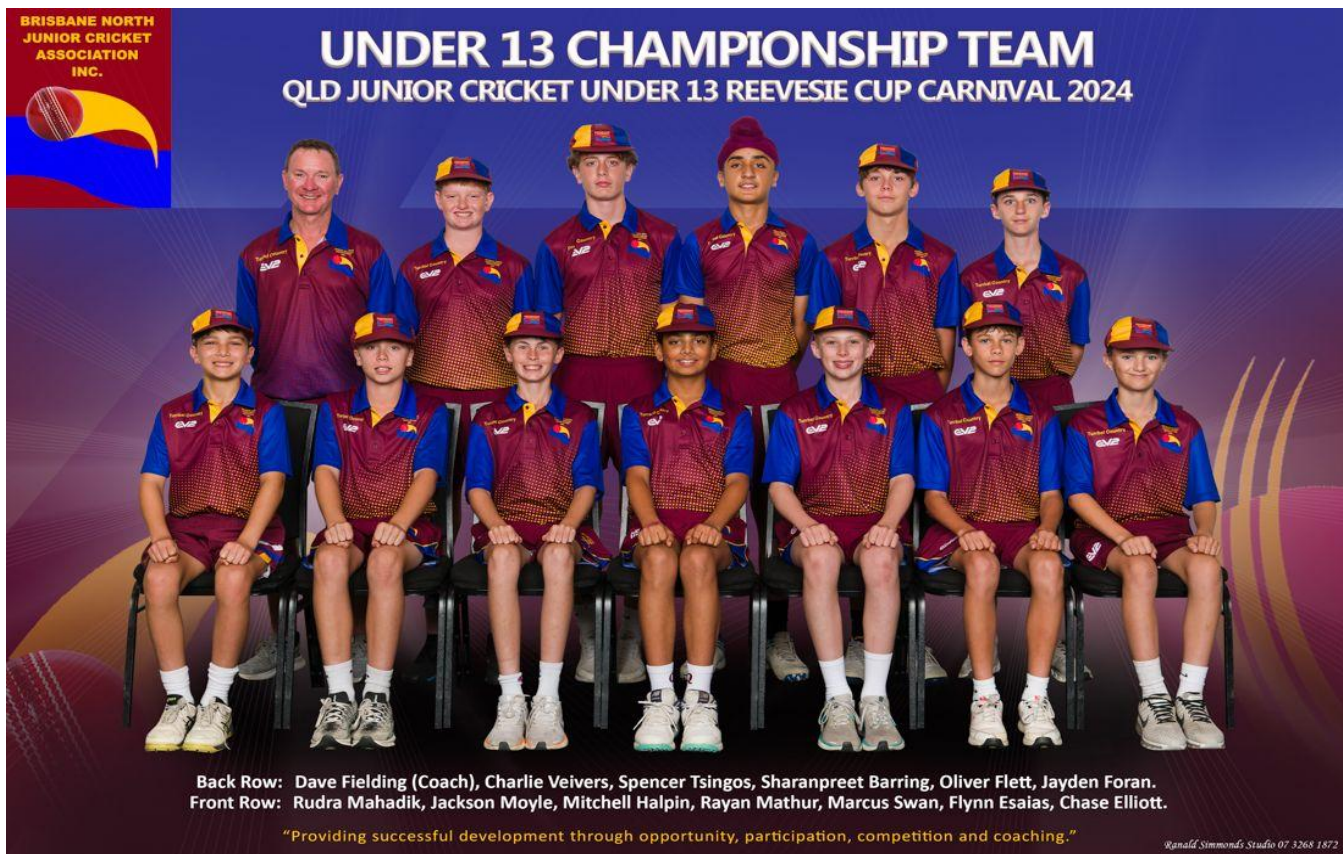
