President's 2025-26 report



The 2025–26 season has again been a strong and positive year for Brisbane North Junior Cricket, built on our core purpose of getting children onto the field and enjoying the game of cricket within a safe, well-organised, and inclusive environment.

Despite ongoing challenges around ground availability, the Association successfully delivered a full season of competition.

Through careful planning, cooperation with councils and clubs, and a willingness by many to be flexible when required, we managed to accommodate all scheduled games.

While this came close at times, it highlighted the continued dedication and problem-solving approach of Steve and Kathy Casey as they once again produced draws for pre- and post-Christmas seasons to ensure that our young players were able to take the field each week and continue playing the game. Participation remains at the heart of what we do.

Seeing thousands of children across our affiliated clubs actively engaged in cricket each weekend reinforces the importance of our role as one of the largest junior cricket nurseries in Queensland.

The enjoyment, friendships, and life skills developed through junior cricket continue to be a defining strength of Brisbane North.

This season we have introduced an academy program that is open to all of those who are selected in stage 2 representative teams. This program has been designed to build the skills that are not coached or practiced in the nets but instead are related to specific fielding techniques, running between wickets, and other such activities.

The stage 1 trials for Under 13 and above still evaluate the core skills of batting, bowling and keeping so players who miss selection in a stage 1 team in one year can still challenge for a spot the next year with no detriment in not attending the academy.

The purpose of the academy is to improve the overall performance of players in stage 2 and stage 3 competitions and have them better prepared for representative carnivals.

Looking forward, the Association has identified several key focus areas that will guide our work in the coming seasons.

The first is **Infrastructure development**.

Demand for quality playing fields and training facilities continues to grow alongside participation. We will continue to work collaboratively with local councils, Queensland Cricket, and clubs to advocate for both improved and additional infrastructure so that participation can be sustained and expanded in a safe and enjoyable manner.

The second key focus area is **Player retention**.

While attracting new players to the game is important, ensuring that existing players continue to enjoy cricket and remain involved through their junior years is equally vital.

Information from Cricket Australia indicates that for all the new player signing up for cricket each season, just short of half this number do not return to keep playing junior cricket.

We are currently looking at ways to engage with more players at a skill and social level that suits their needs because we recognise that every player's journey in cricket is different.

The third key focus area is **Cultural diversity**.

This is an area that has been brought into sharper focus for me over the last few months.

Over the last several years we have been witness to our club teams and representative teams becoming more reflective of the diversity of Australian culture.

This is a good thing because true Australian culture is about a mixture of immigrant cultures. Let's be honest, unless you are a full-blood first nations person then your ancestors either paid to come to Australia or they were sent here in chains.

I imagine all of us in this room are a product of immigration. Our national culture has evolved over time by absorbing all the cultures we have brought with us. Many of our junior players have emigrated here or are first generation Australians.

I know what that is like because my mother emigrated to Australia as well and that was enough for ignorance and bias to take root in those I went to primary school with.

A few months ago, I had to investigate claims that the parents of one of our Rep teams were over-zealous in their support of the team and the allegation of bullying was also levelled against us.

I'm happy to say the bullying allegation was quickly refuted as a smoke screen for another issue but there were different opinions regarding how "over the top" the support was from our parent group.

I sought counsel on cultural perspective from a friend and he said to me: "Delhi has a population similar to the whole of Australia, and many cities across the Asian sub-continent have an equally dense population. So much is happening there at any time, and it is always so loud. When you grow up in an environment like that, that loudness gets built into who you are."

It highlights that each of us brings our own "ways" to supporting our kids.

As president of the association, I want Brisbane North to welcome the cultures that come to this country, particularly as we are meeting around a common passion.

I would encourage everyone to be themselves when they support their kids AND be accepting of others in the way they support their kids too.

There are two caveats that we must operate by:

- If your actions are causing irritation or offence to others, then back off a bit.
- We go to games to let our kids play cricket. Their fun should be the priority.

We have an opportunity to lead the way in embracing everyone, demonstrating respect, and building a richer cricket culture.

Finally, I would like to sincerely thank our Management Committee, delegates, clubs, coaches, volunteers, parents, and players.

Junior cricket does not happen without the collective effort of many committed people, and Brisbane North is fortunate to benefit from such strong community support. I look forward with confidence to the seasons ahead as we continue to grow participation, improve facilities, and strengthen an inclusive culture that allows every child the opportunity to enjoy the game of cricket.

Treasurer's 2025-26 report

The financial statements for the 2025-26 year recorded a net loss of \$19,437.68

Net assets were \$ 275,035.64 last year and they have decreased to \$250,633.96 as at 30 June 2026.

We have spent funds this year, but the condition of the physical assets has improved because of this expenditure. Upgrading of the Number 4 pitch at Kalinga Park continues to be a focus of the Association and these works required considerable expenditure of funds.

In summary, despite having another very active year, we are continuing to review our operations and streamline them where possible.

Player Fees & Club Affiliation fees 2025-26

The player fee structure and affiliation fee amount for the 2025-26 season was increased by \$5.00 this year and this was due to the increased costs that the Association faces.

The Saturday player fee was set at \$25 per player per season and the Blaster fee (formerly Super 6's) was not paid to BNJCA and was paid directly to Cricket Australia when the player signed on for Junior Blaster or Master Blaster. BNJCA does not receive any part of the Blaster sign on fee. The annual BNJCA club affiliation fee remained set at \$1 per club.

Draw Committee 2025-26 report



For the 2025 / 26 season we had a total of 244 teams in the Pre - Xmas draw for U10 – Open age division. This was an increase from the 227 teams we had in the 2024 / 25 season. BNJCA had similar increases in the Post Xmas Draws where we went from 125 teams in 2024 /25 to 140 teams this season. We experienced the usual drop in numbers for our older age divisions where many of our juniors go off to play in senior competitions like the Premier Grade or Warehouse Cricket and Sub-Districts cricket. Promisingly for the future of BNJCA, we had huge increases in the number of players in our U10 and U11 age divisions.

BNJCA welcomed Brisbane Grammar School to our ranks this season with eight teams and fortunately they were able to provide six new grounds, two of which were turf wickets. This was very much appreciated by the Draw Committee as we did lose a few of our school ovals. For the inner-city clubs like Valleys, Wilston North and Toombul, grounds are always going to be an issue as they have big numbers and there are just not enough parks or schools available. BNJCA will depend on the outer suburbs in the Moreton Bay City Region where councils are becoming more aware of the issues of green space where ovals are needed.

We did have the usual problems caused by wet weather, but these were overcome with the assistance of club officials who notified me earlier in the week of pending difficulties with wet grounds. Normally the Pre - Xmas season, things are always tight as there are not many spare ovals.

Thank you to the many State and Private Schools which allowed us to use their ovals during the season. I would also like to express our appreciation for the continuing support from Brisbane City Council, Moreton Bay City Council, Warehouse Cricket and those District Cricket Clubs which made ovals available. BNJCA could not operate such a large competition without their assistance and support.

I would also like to acknowledge the assistance given to me by Kathy Casey in compiling our draws. She provides all the technical know-how to complete these documents.

Grants Committee 2025-26 report

Each year BNJCA provides grants to affiliated clubs, to assist in bringing new fields into use and ensuring that grounds that are used by the BNJCA, are kept in a safe and useable condition. We approve grants for repairs and new pitch installations but do not approve grants for practice nets as these are not required to play cricket on Saturday mornings. The Grants Policy and application form are available for downloading from the website www.bnjca.org.au

We allocated a total of **\$17,084** on grants for pitches and with the BCC also doing ground improvements like aeration, weed control and fertiliser application, we look forward to improving the quality of facilities for all users in the future. The Management Committee is currently in negotiations with Brisbane City Council to extend these remediation works across more of the parks that we hold licences for. The BNJCA contributed **\$4,545** as part of the funding required to complete the lighting project at the Lakes Cricket Club.

We continue to provide grants to clubs to upgrade the pitches that are used for the junior competitions. However, given the costs associated to have new surfaces installed on pitches we are limited to how many grants we can undertake each year. The BNJCA continues to support clubs wherever it is possible.

A new clothing design was used again this year and all representative teams including the Championship category wearing the coloured clothing. With the introduction of the BNJCA Academy players were able to secure a training shirt.

Representative team photos were again completed on the same evening as the Cap Presentation Night. Thanks to Randal Simmonds Photography who catered for these new arrangements and were able to deliver the photos on time.

The BNJCA appreciates and acknowledges the fantastic ongoing support provided by Keith Dudgeon Sports, Emu Sportswear, Starline Promotions, Blaze Cricket and Extreme Marquees.

Facilities 2025-26 report

Kalinga pitches continue to be mowed by a contractor in addition to Brisbane City Council. The Association has received complementary advice regarding the standard of the ovals at Kalinga Park, and we receive many requests to use the ovals for their community cricket games and other events. The BCC has again undertaken a program to aerate, weed manage and fertilize the Kalinga Park ovals again this year.

With a mix of grants, club and BNJCA contributions, we have resurfaced pitches at the Bray Park State School, South Pine Sports, Everton Districts Cricket Club and Albany Creek State School, as well as contributing to the construction and completion of the lighting project at the Lakes Cricket Club at a total cost \$17,084. These facilities increase the ovals available for the Saturday morning competitions as well improving the standard of the pitch. Continued pitch vandalization and extreme weather conditions have put an extra burden on the clubs and BNJCA. The considerable costs associated with resurfacing the pitches is approximately \$7500 to \$8,000.

I wish to thank Warehouse Cricket for use of the two Seventh Brigade Parks and Marchant Oval #3 for use of these ovals each Saturday morning and the use of Warehouse Cricket, Albany Creek CC and Everton DCC grounds for Casey, Reevesie and ALF competitions is also appreciated.

We continue to encourage clubs to actively check ovals and green space in their area to see if any potential new playing areas can be utilized. If some ovals are currently unable to be used because of their playing surface, please contact Jeanette Davidson at Qld Cricket and talk about what can be done to get them operational again, this includes any schools, parks or virgin green space.

Representative Manager 2025-26 report

We had a very successful 25-26 representative season, with five teams winning their respective carnival. Congratulations to the following winning teams: U15 Championship Team (Dave Rockley Cup); U12 Maroon (Ian Healy Cup), U13 Maroon (LJ Hooker – Ballina); U14 Blue (Don Bambling Cup) and U15 Blue (Glynn Williams Cup). We also had another 4 teams that made it to the final: U12 Championship Team (Don Proctor Cup); U13 Championship Team (Reevesie Cup); U12 Blue (Ian Healy Cup) and U13 Blue (Les Kinnane Memorial Shield).

The initial Stage 1 trials for both boys' and girls' representative teams for the 26-27 season were conducted as usual in February. The nominated players for next year's rep players increased across nearly all ages in comparison to previous seasons. There was a total of 82 nominations for U12, 99 nominations for U13 boys, 112 nominations for U14 boys, 93 nominations for U15 boys, 20 nominations for U13 girls and 34 nominations for U15 girls. We also had 82 players nominate to be considered for the U16 championship team.

All four Stage 2 squads have been selected for the U12 Casey Cup, the U13 Reevesie Cup, the U14 Anstey La Frantz Shield and the U15 JP Cup. The JP Cup will be held on 3 consecutive Sundays in July/August 2026, and the Casey Cup, Reevesie Cup and Anstey La Frantz Shield will be held on 3 consecutive Sundays in October 2026. The Girls U13 and Girls U15 squads have been selected, and they are scheduled to play their Stage 2 trial game in August 2026. Brisbane North had nine boys selected to contest the Queensland U16 Male State Challenge and two girls selected to contest the U15 Female State Challenge.

Given the large number of players attending our Stage 1 trials, it is a significant day for both players and selectors. We sincerely thank all players who took part and conducted themselves so well. We also extend our gratitude to the club volunteers who helped select the Stage 2 squads across each age group. This selection process would not be possible without your support, and we greatly appreciate the time and effort you contributed.

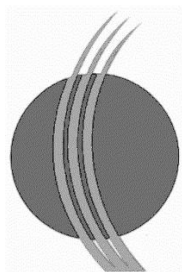

Summary of Awards 25-26

The Spirit of Cricket Award

Patrick Stringer

Cricket is a game that owes much of its unique appeal to the fact that it should be played not only within its Laws but also within the Spirit of the Game. Any action which is seen to abuse this spirit causes injury to the game itself. The Spirit of the Game involves respect for:

- Your opponents
- Your own captain and team
- The role of the umpires
- The game's traditional values

The BNJCA supports the Spirit of Cricket, as embodied in the preamble to the Laws of Cricket, in a tangible way, with a Spirit of Cricket Award. The Association accepts nominations from clubs for a player displaying the true spirit, traditions, and values of cricket. The player must be playing in a BNJCA competition. This award does not apply to adults.

In order for a club to nominate a player, the action must be at the player's instigation, not a result of an adult's intervention. The nomination can come from anyone involved in the game other players, umpire, coach or spectators, but must be made through the affiliated club of the nominating person.

Patrick told the umpire that he should call him back because he knocked the bails off with his glove without the ball in his hand and it should be not out.

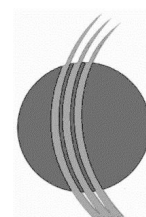
